 - ii. Funding request from Shahna Schultz for Multicultural Title I Parent/Family Engagement Night -- Funding request for \$100.00, for hot dogs/buns and supplies.
 - A motion by Jeff Bold to approve the funding request, and seconded by Ira Rivera. (APPROVED)
- III. Old Business
 - We have spent all but \$1.99 for the SMART Bond
- IV. Administrator's Report (given by Kathy Good, Coconut Creek Elementary Principal)
 - CCES is currently running our Academic Camps for Reading and Math. The Academic Camps are for students in the lower quartile.
 - ii. We are in the process of forming our Art and Science Enrichment Camps.
 - iii. We are currently running an ESOL Enrichment Camp for primary level students
 - iv. Mrs. Good was able to hire two Title I Paraprofessionals Mrs. Heim and Ms. Norton. The Paraprofessionals will help teachers with push-in groups.
 - v. On Wednesday, March 13, 2019 at 6:30 P.M. and Tuesday, March 19th at 9:00 A.M., CCES will be hosting our Kindergarten Round Up. This event is for all incoming families of kindergarteners for the 2019/2020 school year.
