March 11<sup>th</sup>, 2019

- I. **Approval of Minutes from February Meeting**
  - i. A motion from the floor by Jeff Bold to approve the February School Advisory Council minutes, and seconded by Doris Ferdous.
  
- II. **SAC Funding Balance / Requests**
  - i. As of March 11<sup>th</sup>, 2019, SAC has \$1,607.65 in our account.
  - ii. **Funding request from Shahna Schultz for Multicultural Title I Parent/Family Engagement Night** – Funding request for \$100.00, for hot dogs/buns and supplies.
    - a. A motion by Jeff Bold to approve the funding request, and seconded by Ira Rivera. (**APPROVED**)
  
- III. **Old Business**
  - i. We have spent all but \$1.99 for the SMART Bond
  
- IV. **Administrator's Report** (*given by Kathy Good, Coconut Creek Elementary Principal*)
  - i. CCES is currently running our Academic Camps for Reading and Math. The Academic Camps are for students in the lower quartile.
  - ii. We are in the process of forming our Art and Science Enrichment Camps.
  - iii. We are currently running an ESOL Enrichment Camp for primary level students
  - iv. Mrs. Good was able to hire two Title I Paraprofessionals – Mrs. Heim and Ms. Norton. The Paraprofessionals will help teachers with push-in groups.
  - v. On Wednesday, March 13, 2019 at 6:30 P.M. and Tuesday, March 19<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 A.M., CCES will be hosting our Kindergarten Round Up. This event is for all incoming families of kindergarteners for the 2019/2020 school year.

- vi. CCES will be hosting our First Annual Multicultural Night / Book Fair Night next month.
- vii. PTA is hosting our 2019 Spring Fling on Wednesday, March 20<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 P.M.

**VI. School Improvement / Title I**

- i. Parents found section 5 of the Parent Compact was not compatible to school board policy. So the section was amended and approved.

- iii. Parents were involved in the decision regarding how the school's 2019/2020 Parental Involvement Allocation will be used, as outlined in the PFEP.

  - 2. Threat Assessment process has changed with the School District
    - a. All threats are investigated by Administration, Officer Dan (School Resource Officer), and Coconut Creek Department.
  - 3. Some parents have voiced their feelings with other parents and shared that they feel that the front office staff aren't the most welcoming toward parents and guests.
