3. Principal's Comments
 - a. SAFE survey tomorrow for students to voice concerns. District coming in to work on intercoms and get broken ones replaced or repaired.
 - b. Gym completed (flooring) but sound system and scoreboard are still in progress. Hopefully finished by November 2nd when basketball season starts.

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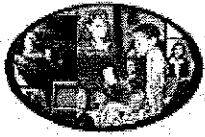
