# Hollywood Hills High School School Advisory Council (SAC)

#### March 5, 2019

#### I. Welcome:

Mr. Reginald Smith, SAC Chair, began the meeting at 4:00 p.m. A quorum was not met.

#### II. Ratification of February 2019 minutes

Mr. Smith opened the meeting requesting to ratify last SAC meeting's minutes and it was 2<sup>nd</sup>, no one opposed.

## III. SUB-committee Updates:

Reginald Smith: Explained that OSPA has received negative comments from the community stating they do not understand the procedures and by-laws and that clearer information must be presented at the meetings. Review of SAC by-laws were briefly explained. All rules and regulations were outlined with a stress on MUST BE FOLLOWED. Mr. Smith stated every member present during the meetings must be clear on all the procedures. If anyone is not, they were invited to contact Mr. Smith or Ms. Perez as needed. Smith stated Hollywood Hills was in good standing and up to date on all procedures as per OSPA's district office.

Smith also stated the election committee is set up for anyone that would like to run for any position. The person would just give their name during the election process. Once again, he stated if anyone had a question or concern to please contact him and/or Ms. Perez. He quickly added the stake holder survey was posted on the Hollywood Hills main page and asked that everyone please take a moment and answer the questions. Ms. Perez stated this survey is important to help the school address areas of concern.

Mr. Antoniotti (math) wanted to update the committee on the success of their investment in his program earlier in the year. He stated the bottom 23% of the students were now answering their homework questions correctly 75% of the time, when the program began they were at 40%. He went on to explain that the homework is based on basic math, as is their EOC test. Students are feeling more successful, which, he feels, is the reason they are showing more effort on their homework assignments.

Ms. Ospina (testing) Testing is approaching with the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students taking the FSA Writing exam April 3 & 4 and the Reading May 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>.

Ms. Ospina stated there is a need for a Literacy Camp to target the bubble students which are composed of 132 students at the FSA level 3.
