- a. Chuck-E-Cheese Night Summary

Parent and report card night was a success. Report cards were passed out. The Chuck-E-Cheese management gave praise and offered future night events.

A program at Markham that honors students that display up to 8 targeted positive characteristics.

- c. 5,000 Role Models Mentoring for Young Men Update

A new program that is starting at Markham. Selected 5th grade boys will mentor selected lower grade level boys.

Mr. Dukes is looking into a program with Cavalry Chapel for mentoring girls in order to provide the girls a similar experience.

- d. Equity Liaison Update

Ms. Bardwell and Mr. McCloud are the Equity Liaisons that represent our school.

- e. SAF – School Advisory Forum

The School Advisory Forum is a meeting for parents to participate in and serve as a voice for the school/community.

We are looking for a parent to represent Markham Elementary at the SAF meetings.

A presenter will be coming to one of our next SAC meetings to share information about training/schooling opportunities available.

f. A+ Incentive Funds

\$46,786 in A+ funds allocated to Markham Elementary.

A teacher survey was completed regarding A+ spending options. The SAC committee is required to participate in the approval of the proposals of how the money is to be spent. Once the proposals are approved by the SAC committee, they will be voted on by the staff. If the proposals are not approved, the proposals can be revised.

Proposal options were solicited to the SAC Committee.

1. Praise was given for the options that the dollar amount be shared with everyone. However, it was felt that a percentage should be shared with the students as well.

90% to staff; equally; 10% to students

2. All options proposed should have 10% allocated to the students.

3. Discussed if a larger percentage should be given to teachers than support staff that do not provide instructional support.

4. Discussed if Instructional and Non - Instructional should receive a different percentage.

5. Discussed if ESP's should be considered Non - Instructional

6. Discussed how much money is given to each category in lieu of percentages to each category.

7. 70/20/10, 60/30/10, 50/40/10 estimated dollars amounts were discussed.

9. Agreement made the money would be given to those working at Markham last school year.

10. The proposed Ballot was written out and approved after discussions.

11. Staff ballot voting results will be shared at the next SAC meeting.
