 - o Ms. Duperval: Students will visit UCLA and Cal State. There are two IB world schools students will also visit. Recreationally students will be going to Madame Toussauds, Universal Studios, the Grammys, the Oscars, Santa Monica Pier, and Pacific Park. Further educational tours are also scheduled outside of schools to the Griffith Observatory and Planetarium, and the Museum of the Queen Mary Ship.
