Minutes:

School Improvement Plan 2018-2019:

- 0 to 2 absences the teacher reaches out to the family.

- Mrs. Cardet and Ms. Darley (SAC Chairpersons) reviewed the 2018-2019 School Improvement Plan in an effort to allow parents to make suggestions for revisions on the 2019-2020 School Improvement Plan. The SAC Chairpersons informed the parents that they could review the School Improvement Plan further and will have the opportunity to make changes at the next SAC meeting.
