

- **Standard 5- Standard 5: Using Results for Continuous Improvement**
- The school implements a comprehensive assessment system that generates a range of data about student learning and school effectiveness and uses the results to guide continuous improvement.



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Positive Behavior implementation Support (PBIS)- The broad purpose of PBIS is to improve the effectiveness, efficiency, and equity of schools and other agencies. PBIS improves social, emotional academic outcomes for all students, including students with disabilities and students from underrepresented groups (Positive Behavior Implementation Support, 2019). Cypress Elementary holds meetings and monitors data collected to determine if PBIS Tier I strategies are effective.

SAC/SAF Meeting Minutes

Quorum was established. SAC meeting was called to order at 2:30.

Review of the December 20th meeting was approved by Ms. Knight and Ms. Bray

Ms. Eikenberry spoke of the Advanced Ed Survey Standard number 5: Using Results for Continuous Improvement.

Ms. Eikenberry gave an overview of the PBIS. Trends: noticed areas of concern in the classrooms, hallways, and buses. Administrative actions to decrease instances were discussed.

Ms. Eikenberry reviewed the mid-year review with parents and staff present. The mid-year review was approved.

SAF Meeting was called to order at 3:00:

Ms. Bray presents Title 1 Update: Annual Title 1 Parent Engagement Seminar February 2, 2019 at Signature Grand.

Mrs. Schnur presents the Principal Report:

Discussed school data: 36% predicted proficiency in ELA and 40% predicted proficiency in Math based on AP 2 iReady Diagnostic data. The results revealed good learning gains. The data will provide instructional implications for teachers moving forward.

There are 7 categories for school grade (lists all 7 categories). We will be looking at multiple data points such as iReady, BSA, to provide information on what our students need to progress academically. Teachers will be digging deep into the standards with standards mastery.

Construction Update: Working in primary wing on AC units, and the roof construction is projected to be completed by March/April.

Grade Level Awards: Awards Assemblies for grades 3-5 will be hosted on 1 day. Students will be presented with Principal and A/B honor roll. The grade level teachers will present other awards in individual classrooms.

Balanced Literacy Pathway for teachers: ensuring teachers are using best practices to instruct in ELA.

The floor was opened for discussion.
