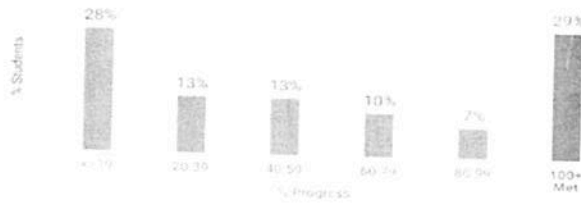
Progress to Annual Typical Growth (Median)

The median percent progress towards Typical Growth for this school is 55%. Typical growth is the average annual growth for a student at their grade and placement level.

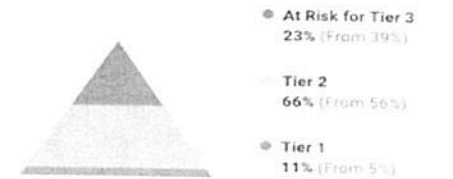
Distribution of Progress to Annual Typical Growth

SAC/SAC Meeting

Quorum established. SAC meeting was called to order at 2:30.

Review of November meeting minutes was reviewed.
Kane 1st approved and Knight Approved 2nd

The floor was opened with discussion AdvancEd Standards
The SIP was monitored and Best practice 1 was discussed and explained.

Voting of the SIP was approved. The floor was open for parents to make suggestions and/or comments. There were no suggestions and/or comments. Any parent may request a hard copy of the SIP; It's available in the front office. Each committee is made up of 51% parents and 49% teacher.

The floor was open for any question.

SAF was called to order at 3:00.

Title Report-

We are looking for 3 parents to be sponsors to attend the Annual Title 1 Parent Night held at Signature Grand. This year keynote speaker is Manuel Scott. The event will take place on February 2nd, 2019. Look for information for Annual parent survey.

Principal report-

Ms. Schnur discussed the Title 1 funds:

Instructional Materials and trainings for teachers to attend PLCs.

The monies from Title 1 also is put towards events at night: refreshments, material and decorations.

Additional funding was received and put towards to enhance learning or additional procedures. Funds are used for I-Ready materials, site licenses and

I-Ready diagnostics- A variety of skills were assessed. The students have shown a tremendous amount of growth. In math, the 1st assessment, students were at 13 percent and are expected

to show growth by 30 percent. In the 2nd assessment, students have moved from a 13 percent to a 16 percent. The skill was measurement and geometry.

A question was asked by a member if I-Ready materials could be used in after care services.

Teachers are now expected to go back review data to see if students have grown in levels. This will help predict student's progress on FSA in May.

Upcoming assessments in January will be BSA- Broward Standard Assessment.

This assessment will assess in science, reading and math. This will give data on FSA results WIDA will be assessed: reading, language and writing.

Construction updates- Student bathrooms will be ready to use in January. New circulation desk is placed in the media center. We are looking to upgrade furniture in the media center.

Progress has been made in the unit ventilator system. The primary building will begin during the holiday break. The roof will be completed soon and additional surveillance cameras (picks up infrared and movement) will be added.

The floor was open for questions.

Meeting was adjourned 3:30pm.
