





The Purpose of SAC

The role of the School Advisory Council (SAC) is to facilitate the development & monitor progress of the School Improvement Plan (SIP).

Each school is required to establish a School Advisory Council (SAC) that is representative of the population served by the school. Per State statute (S 1001.452) a majority of the SAC members cannot be employees of the Broward County Public Schools.

SAC Positions for Parent (2019-2020)

- **Parents representatives**
- **Innovation Zone representative (must be a parent elected after SAC is formed)**
- **SAF Chairperson (or designee – must be a parent)**
- **ESOL representative (must be a parent of a student an ELL student)**
- **ESE representative (must be a parent of an ESE student)**
- **Gifted representative (must be a parent of a Gifted student at the school)**
- **Pre-K (if applicable - parent or certified teacher)**

- **Quiet Zones-** The safety infrastructure for the Florida East Cost (FEC) Railroads, including Brightline trains, is expected to be completed April 11, 2019. The FEC quiet zones are anticipated to go into effect the first week of May, at least 21 days from the date the infrastructure is completed. Since quiet zones are brand new to Broward County, we want to make sure we are ahead of the curve and can start educating schools and parents on what quiet zones are and how you can be safe.


- A Quiet Zone is a section of rail line at least one-half mile in length that contains one or more consecutive public highway rail grade crossings where locomotive horns are not sounded upon the train's approach, although train horns may be sounded for emergency situations at the conductor's discretion. Quiet Zones are being established on both the Florida East Coast (FEC) and CSX tracks in Broward County.

The purpose of SAC was discussed. The SAC committee is to serve as improving and implementing the School Improvement Plan.

SAF Meeting was called to order at 9:30

Ms. Bray presented Title 1.

School Improvement Plan – We are currently working on the School Improvement Plan for the 2019-2020 school year. Development of the plan includes input from parents. This is a fluid document that is used to monitor progress towards our goals at Cypress. When return from summer break, we will continue to develop the plan and receive input and review from all stakeholders, including parents. The SIP will addressed at our first SAC meeting of the 2019-2020 school year.

The Title I Parental Involvement Allocation budget for the 2019-2020 was proposed. The purchase of student agendas, student communication folders, refreshments for parent nights, and fees to attend annual parent seminar will be allocated. The floor was opened to adjust/provide input to the allocation of parent involvement funds. No additional suggestions were provided. Parents approved of the proposed allocation.

Title 1 Parent and Family Engagement Plan Review: Ms. Bray discussed parental participation and outcomes in various activities offered for the 2018-2019 school year: Meet and Greet 401 parent participants, Curriculum Harvest Festival 129 parent participants, ESOL Game Night 111 parent participants, and Multicultural/Wax Museum Night 126 parent participants. Barriers will continue to be addressed by providing opportunities for parents to receive training and resources to assist their students academically and socially.

Ms. Bray presented the Parent and Family Engagement Survey Summary Results: 109 parents responded when asked how they feel about parental involvement, resources to help students with school, communication, and collaboration. As a school, we want to increase parental
