

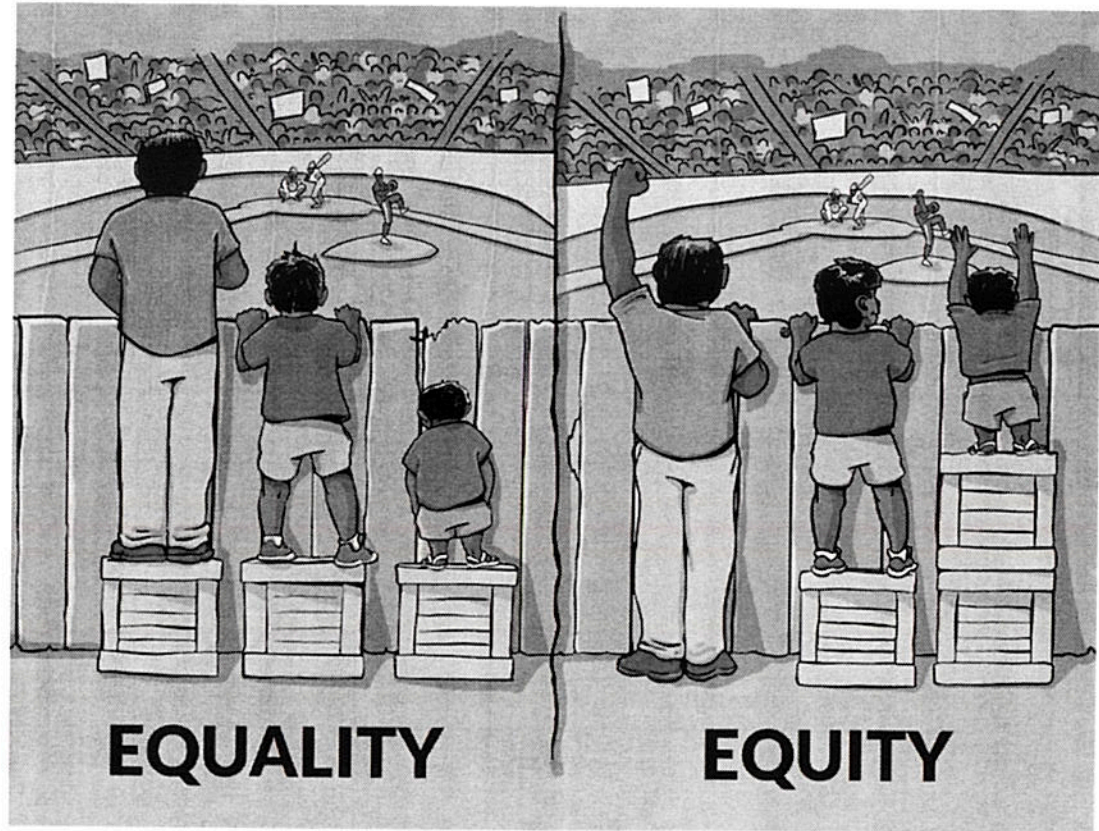

Principal Update:

- Smart Bond has been used towards technology, new playground, painting of the school, construction done on A/C units and ventilators. Bathrooms are being renovated and going through inspections.
- ready diagnostics are used in the beginning of the school year to assess students to better meet their needs. The data used will assist teachers to change instruction. 3 through 5 take the FSA and the iReady helps students with state exams. K-2 grades are exposed to what to expect with answering tough questions.
- MSD act requires every school to have an armed officer on campus to protect students and staff. The city determines funding to keep an actual deputy/police officer on campus. We are in the process of determining if we will keep both the armed safe guard and SRO- Deputy Avila.
