

- The school's curriculum, instructional design, and assessment practices guide and ensure teacher effectiveness and student learning.



Update on the construction was discussed and the next phase for completion.

Title 1 funds are now available for PD, ELO, Supplemental materials, technology program that were identified in the plan. Completed summative in ELA- key ideas and details, and in mathoperations for 2-5 (analyzing data/driving instruction), and BAS for primary monitoring.

I-Ready Diagnostic 2 is in December. BAS calibration- K-2 conversation for alignment among grade-level.

A request to use funds- unused supply monies from teachers goes back to school. SAC has \$3,818 for funds available. Ms. Schnur is requesting to purchase 2 or more BAS kits for K/1 at \$850 from Fountas and Pinelle. Shared reading supplemental material guides for 2nd which can be shared with 1st grade for \$1650.
