As authorized in Florida State Statute Section 1008.36, the program provides greater autonomy and financial awards to schools that demonstrate sustained or significantly improved student performance. Schools that receive an A grade or schools that improve at least one performance grade category are eligible for school recognition. Cooper City High School sustained an A grade for the 2017-2018 school year.
- b. The staff and school advisory council jointly decides how to use the financial award. As specified in statute, schools must use their awards for one or any combination of the following:

  - ii. Nonrecurring faculty and staff bonuses;

  - A. Math – Mr. Souza
    - o Teachers are continuing to meet with their Professional Learning Communities (PLC) to review data and create common assessments.
    - o PSAT scores will be available in December.
    - o Teachers are starting to plan for the start of after school EOC camp.
  - B. Social Studies – Mr. Dixon & Mrs. Wilfong
    - o GOVERNMENT: Review and group presentations of the 2018 midterm elections. Students were assigned candidates and amendments to research and present out to their classmates.
    - o History: the US history teachers are preparing for a competitive review game to include all teachers in the US history department. Students will be competing against each other. The winning team will be rewarded with a pizza party.
    - o EOC goal focusses on improving the history pass rate from an 83% - 90%.
