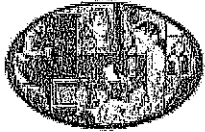

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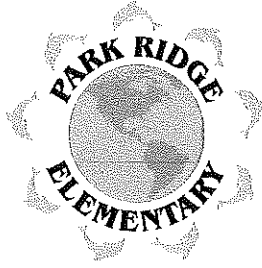

Call to Order:

A meeting of the Park Ridge School Advisory Council was held in the Media Center on February 20th 2019. Co-Chair Tracy Williams called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM. Cherelle Martin will record minutes for this meeting.

Minutes:

Review of SAC's minutes:

For meeting on January 23rd, 2019. SMART Bond will release approx. \$100,000 toward Park Ridge that SAC will vote on for the 2019-2020 school year. There will be a presentation by the district for March's meeting to discuss how the SMART bond is spent. B is inviting parents to the classroom, possibly a SAC breakfast and class walkthrough.

Black History Month:

Safety and Security:

Park Ridge is working to keep students alert. Teachers and students are practicing what to do in the case of an evacuation. This drill will be happening soon for our school, so letters have gone home to notify parents of the upcoming drill. Parent links will be sent out during and after the drill to notify them of the measures taken. Please ensure contact numbers on file at school are updated. Drills for code reds and yellow will continue throughout the year.

New Business:

Principal's Word:

This meeting focuses on safety and security, school data, and Title 1 updates.

School updates:

K-2 and 3-5 are going through the process of mid-year data chats to focus on specific instruction and pull out for students. Teachers and staff are working hard to target instruction. Thank you for everyone who showed up and

marked in the Pioneer Day Parade for the city. Thanks to all the parents for attending FSA Night. MSD Commemoration went well on February 14th. Zone Showcase at Deerfield Beach High School went well.

Town Safety Meeting -District Wide

At Taravella HS at 6:30 to discuss school safety for the district. They will discuss school measures taken for safety throughout the district. This will review updated technology, radios, etc. needed to maintain school safety.

Safety Updates/Board Updates:

Anyone within the school can call a CODE RED; Safe Spaces/Hard Corner- in the event of an emergency, students and staff will move to a safe place within the classroom/room. The identification of a safe space/hard corner will allow teachers and students to know exactly where to go in any room in the case of an emergency based on the recommendations of our SRO, and the Safe Haven reports of the MSD.

Additional communication should be sent out concerning school traffic patterns with Mrs. Whitehead.

ASP Code Red

SWAT was working within the neighborhood at one house. As a precaution, the Broward Sheriff's Office decided because of the proximity, the school should be placed on a code red- lockdown. The lockdown only focused on students who were here at ASP, but all parents were notified. Parents were notified during and immediately after the event, but students were always safe.
