A meeting of the Park Ridge School Advisory Council was held in the Media Center on May 23rd, 2019.

Principal's Word:

School updates: Spring break is coming soon; Spring break packet has been given out to the students. The packet is optional for students to complete. March 22-29. Career Day was a successful hit! Many students were able to meet multiple professionals. Third Grade starts FSA on April 2nd, immediately after spring break. FSA Rally will be April 26th for the school-wide celebrations. Ensure students are practicing over the break to maintain their knowledge.

School Safety Updates: Code Orange drill completed. Students were safe and followed directions very well. BSO and the fire department all agreed that Park Ridge students transitioned well for the evacuation drill.

Review Policy 2120: Emergency Codes Prevention & Preparedness: any adult can call a code red on campus, within their right.

Review Policy 2150: Safer Spaces location within schools, identified by the BSO and district.
These two policies are mandatory to be followed across the district and grade levels.

Old Business:

Review of SAC's minutes:

For meeting on April 25th, 2019. Meeting held in Media Center at alternative time of 8:30 AM. Review of SMART bond monies to be distributed to the schools and how it should be used for Park Ridge. School Updates:

Park Ridge will be an ESY/Summer School location for the 2019 Summer. There will be an SRO on campus during the summer. In the 2019-2020 school year, Park Ridge will have an SRO and a Campus Monitor funded by Deerfield Beach. Dad's Day was hosted: over 80 parents or fathers showed up. Literacy Night was hosted, and it was engaging event and how to avoid the summer slide! Provided local public library resources, District ESOL department assisted, and technological resources were provided. PreK/HS Moving up ceremony on 5/24. On May 28 and 29 will be the Park Ridge Olympics for K-4, parents welcome. Honor Assembly on the 28th and 29th. May 31st will be Staff vs. Fifth

Grade Kickball game; June 3rd is the Fifth Grade Moving Up Ceremony. Last day of school is June 4th/Early Release Day. First day of the 2019-2020 school year is Wednesday, 8/14 and Meet and Greet is Tuesday, 8/13.

Next SAC Meeting for 2019-2020:

First date will be announced soon, near September to discuss SMART Bond Funds (\$100,000). During alternative scheduled visit, try to do it prior to testing season (suggested by SAC member)

Possible PTO/PTA organization creation: Suggested by SAC voting member; needs a minimum of 4 members to create a Board, with a monthly meeting and a committee. Will take a list of interested parents who may be willing to meet in the summer to establish a committee/board.
