PRINCIPAL UPDATE:

The district moved to manage-print services. This is a centralized printing instead of having to buy toner. It creates a creation to have multiple teachers printing. Mr. Santana is advocating for more toner and the need to have printers. Some consideration should be given to move gradually. Mr. Santana is trying to have multiple units available. Mr. Santana is inquiring daily about this concern. Ms. McBurrows inquired about using Title I funds to be utilized. Orders for toners have gotten kicked back. Ms. Alvarez asked about how much toner is. Mr. Santana said it is about \$100 per cartridge of toner.

VAM scores were released and we came out in the 80^{th} percentile. We are 7^{th} in the county. This demonstrates teacher efficacy and the best apples to apples comparison. Kudos to teachers and instructional coaches. CPCA recruitment event will be happening on Tuesday, December 4^{th} . Timelines are being reviewed and extended learning opportunities are happening.

Saturday Academy will be happening on December 1st. Targeting 100 students are projected to come. See Saturday Academy plan. Ms. Alvarez inquired about ESOL parents and students and that information is disseminated in English and Spanish.

Ms. Rodriguez inquired about the program and if any student can come.

Title I funds will be used to purchase 200 computers for the school (4 carts).

Math Night was incredible and interactive.

Literacy Night on December 6th will be happening.
