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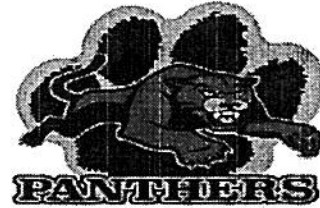

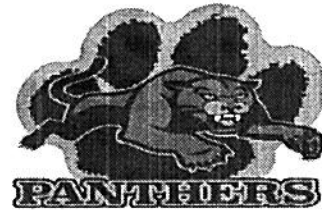

Students are challenged to read 9,000 books this year as a part of our reading challenge.

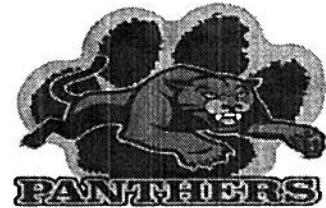
