**Call to Order:**

A meeting of the Cypress Run Education Center School Advisory Council was held in the School Library on 4/09/2019. Dr. Belter called the meeting to order at 4:00PM. Dr. Belter recorded minutes for this meeting.

**Meeting Minutes Today April 9, 2019:**

- Discussion of PBIS/SIP:
  - Ms. Jackson discussed, the School Wide Positive Behavior Plan has been completed by the PBIS & SIP committee members. The plan will be presented during the weekly staff meeting for voting and/or approval.
  - All above is part of SIP.
- Additional Agenda:
  - Ms. Jackson discussed that Parent Surveys concerning the school need to be completed soon. Teachers and students are working together to help accomplish the completion of the parent surveys. A minimum of 25% of the parent surveys need to be completed. Students who are helping with this process will be rewarded through PBIS.
  - Dr. Harrigan discussed the total enrollment at Cypress Run is 165 students. By Friday this week, the total student population will reach 170 or more students enrolled at Cypress Run.
  - Dr. Harrigan also mentioned interviews are being conducted for the recently vacated teacher assistant position.
  - Dr. Harrigan mentioned, he will also discuss the budget for Cypress Run at the next SAC meeting, as well as, the budget cuts that will be taking place.
  - Finally, Dr. Harrigan discussed the AES program and how the program is growing in student population, as well as, how it will continue to grow for the following school year.
