A joint meeting of the <u>Atlantic Technical College & Technical High</u> School Advisory Council and School Advisory Forum was held in <u>Room 122 of Atlantic Technical College on May 21, 2019</u>. Chair <u>Jay Ghanem</u> called the meeting to order at <u>8:12 AM</u>. <u>Hallema Collier</u> will record minutes for this meeting.

#### Minutes:

<u>AJ Futo</u> motions to approve the minutes of <u>April 23, 2019</u>, with no corrections. <u>Tatiana Lozada</u> seconded. Motion was unanimously approved.

#### Agenda:

- 1. SAF Update
  - a. Connie Rodriguez shared the calendar proposals for SY 20-21 are on the District website.
- 2. Student Comments
  - a. AJ Futo & Janaai Scott, high school students, shared education events (Aquatic Ecosystem & Green Lawn Company Project), community service (Coconut Creek Teen Political Forum) and school spirit activities (SGA Awards, BPA Nationals, SkillsUSA Nationals).
  - b. Jessica English, Pre-College, discussed project-based learning activity, *Money Matters*, scholarships to CTE programs, and a panel discussion with alumni.
- 3. Assistant Directors' Updates
  - a. Neeta Rancourt shared several updates from the Office of Student Affairs including Life Management Workshop series, Signing Days, and Doris Gonzalez receiving the 2019 College Ready Florida Innovator award. Additionally she provided an update on Perkins V.
  - b. Vicky LaPorte discussed the high school's ranking in in US News & World Report and 2019-2020 enrollment data. Student successes were also shared from Evening among the Stars, Women of Tomorrow, Junior Achievement, and the City of Coconut Creek.
  - c. Andre Newton (Arthur Ashe, Jr campus) reported on PN program and NCLEX results, 2019 Health & Wellness Fair will be 7/13, Haitian Flag Day, and ATCAA Training Programs.
  - d. Tonya Hefley reported on Health Science graduation (145 students from 9 programs!), success at BPA nationals, and Pre-College's Mental Health Awareness month activities.
  - e. John Felser shared that ATC's high school and T-Ten students earned the most ASE's in the county, GNYADA results, High school culinary wins FRLA Award, and a new ESE career training program will begin in the fall.
- 4. Business & Economic Development Nicole Willis
  - a. Career services is very busy with student requests and assisting with resumes.
  - b. ATC's Career Fair: over 70 companies attended.
  - c. Career Source: funding change and increased minimum and can be used before Pell.
  - d. Graduation: Grad Cap Spirit Contest
- 5. Director's Comments Robert Crawford
  - a. Offered thanks to all of the members of SAC/SAF for their participation.
  - b. Provided a Legislative Update: HS & PS CTE bill awaiting signature, equity formula added to budget and Broward is set to receive \$3 million, and the Opportunity Grant of \$10 million was renewed for apprenticeship and pre-apprenticeship

- c. School Budget: \$25 \$28 million with over 600 employees across 3 campuses and equipment upgrades
- d. Program Updates: PN at CCHS in January 2020, looking to expand Electricity, and exploring Aviation/Avionics in partnership with FL Executive Airport and City of Ft. Lauderdale.
- e. SMART: Roof at the Ashe campus awaiting permits. Gave updates on main campus.
- f. Graduation: June 4 HS at 4 PM, PS at 7 PM at Omni Auditorium.
