### **Agenda Item #2-** Parent Participation in Development, Evaluation, and Revision of 2019-2020

School Level Parent and Family Engagement Plan (PFEP)- Ms. Moise **E-4**

- I-ready has been on site every month
- Kids have been excited to participate on the game bus to partake
- Departments meet with primary grades to begin introducing "Blue" lessons
- 75% of all 5<sup>th</sup> grades students are on grade level and predicted to be on level 3 or higher with FSA which has Mr. Frazier as teacher
- What are we going to plan our school with? Last year we had about 5 parent nights. School year 2019-2020 we can have 2 literacy nights, math night, science night, Donuts w/ dads (March), Muffins w/ moms (May), History in heritage (Feb), Health awareness night, Night of nutrition (tie in with our garden), Thanksgiving Night (Nov.), Multicultural Night
- Sun-sentinel came out last week to interview a few students and Mrs. Williams about the garden

- Parents always have a voice through surveys. No current inputs.

**Agenda Item #2B- Review of the 2018-2019 Parent and Family Engagement Plan (PFEP) Form-**

- A summary of the activities designed to build capacity of parents to help their children, professional development were provided. In section #3 of the Review Form of the PFEP listed barriers we found hindered participation by parents in parental involvement activities. In section #4, the parental involvement strategy considered most effective this year was the Pajama Literacy Night Rotation Sessions which provided parents with hands-on assistance. Parents asked for a Health Night to be added as a parental involvement activity.

Ms. Explained that every member of the SAC committee received the NL's school folder which contained the SIP, Title 1 Addendum, SAC Bylaws, SAF Bylaws, etc. Parents were asked to review and provide input.

- Ms. Nieves (PTO and SAC Parent Representative) talked about improving parent involvement through the SIP and Title I Plan.
- No further parent input was provided concerning the School Improvement Plan with Title I Addendum.

- Title 1 we received \$4068 this year (majority of funds go to student planners \$2700 and 3 parents to seminar \$120)

- Rights of a student and parent need 75% returned
- Top 7 Highest areas we scored was information sent home were understandable at 97%
- Top 7 Lowest areas we scored was information from the school about what a score on state test means at 73%

**Agenda Item #6-** Review of 2018-2019 Parent Program/Plan Based on Survey Results & Revisions Made for 2019 Parent and Family Engagement Plan (PFEP) & School Parent Compact. Ms. Moise provided a summary sheet of the top 7 and lowest 7 scoring areas on the Title I Parent Survey Results. The areas scored the lowest were Question #5 (information received about what a score on state tests means) at 73% Strongly Agree and Agree, Question #14 (Went to one or more meetings) at 75%, Question #18 at 75% (Child's school has asked my advice on how they can best teach my child), Question #2 at 76% (I receive information from my child's school about State tests such as the FSA), Question #23 at 77% (The information from my child's school is given in a language that I understand) and Question #25 at 78% (I asked for specific activities, meetings, or materials from my child's school). Ms. Moise stated that she will embed the above areas of concerns during school parent night activities and in our schools Parent and Family Engagement Plan (PFEP) in order to improve in the lowest scoring areas.

Ms. Jilan added that we should provide a Health Awareness Night during Title 1 parent universities to share nutrition and safety routines for families. Also suggested is a Multicultural Night. Parents also reviewed the current PFEP and suggested that we continue with the monthly activities for the new school year in 2019-20.

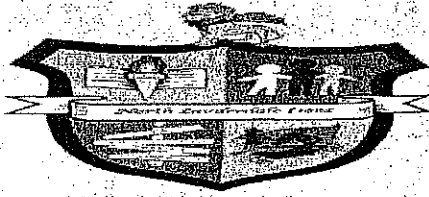



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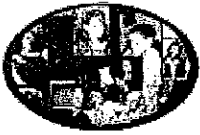
