

 - a. <u>Principal's Report Safety</u>: This will be tabled to the next meeting in January
 - b. <u>Title One</u> Ms. Luckenbach explained the Title One survey. Paper surveys were sent home to selected students across all grade levels.
 The survey is also available on our school website. We use the information from the survey to develop our family engagement plan.
 - c. <u>SAC funds</u> Ms. Puia asked the committee to purchase a Phonics kit for Kindergarten for \$550. This will be voted on in January.

5. Concerns/Celebrations: No Concerns were presented. Celebrations – Our music teacher, Ms. Groulx, organized 2 different holiday music shows. Both shows were well attended and the students performed beautifully. DARE graduation for our 5th graders will be on Friday, December 21st. Officer S has worked with our 5th grade students on the DARE curriculum. Atlantic West now has a campus monitor, he will unlock the gates and monitor the campus for safety. Our students have just completed the 2nd diagnostic for iReady. The students have shown growth in both reading and math. Ms. Oppy reviewed the upcoming test dates for the BSA and FSA. The county has required each school to have an equity liaison. Our liaison is Ms. Ritter, she has developed a year long plan for equity training for our staff. Ms. Beish explained the Best Buddies program at Atlantic West. Tomorrow is the Best Buddies holiday party with Coconut Creek High School. Ms. Beish also explained the News to You program that the ESE department recently purchased. This program uses current events across the curriculum. Ms. Arbogast asked the parents if there are any topics that they would like to learn more about during the SAC meetings. Ms. Whyte asked for more curriculum support for at home.
