Minutes

1. Welcome – Ms. Arbogast welcomed everyone to the meeting
2. Review of Minutes – Need to correct the word meeting to motion in item #2,
Ms. Oppy motioned to approve the minutes, Ms. Beisch seconded the motion.
3. Officer Scaperrotta and Officer Druzvik – Internet Safety Presentation –
There are 2 billion people online today. There are an estimated 50,000 predators online looking for potential victims. Guidelines – do not allow your children on the internet in their bedroom or private area, they need to have parent supervision, set time restraints. You should check the history of your children's devices. Children lie about their ages to create accounts on social media. Cyberbullying takes place over digital devices. It includes posting harmful or false content about someone else. Cyberbullying is not always visible. We need to have open lines of communication with our children.
Teach children never to reveal any personal information over the internet and

anything posted online will always be out there. Identity theft happens to children because of their clean credit.

a. SIP Plan Status – our SIP plan was approved

5. School Choice Update – The window opens December 1st, we will look at the students in our 4year old Headstart students to encourage them to sign up for school choice.

6. New Business

a. Principal's Report – Safety: New cameras were installed today in the cafeteria and the school perimeter. They include a motion sensor which will allow us to monitor our campus 24 hours a day. We are continuing to conduct our monthly code red drills and all our staff has been trained.

b. Afterschool Care Program Choices: At this time, our aftercare providers are CAS and YMCA. Every year we determine if we want to continue with the providers or look for other providers. Ms. Precious from the YMCA told the committee that they love being at Atlantic West and have formed a great partnership with the school. Both programs run effectively, and we plan to continue with our

partnerships. Ms. Joseph asked if there was an option for aftercare for our Headstart students.

7. Concerns/Celebrations: We just had our first attendance party of the year, which has been sponsored by the YMCA. Our first quarter museum showcase was a huge success! Our second-grade team performed songs about the water cycle. A church group in Margate has offered to volunteer for a beautification project for our campus. Ms Beisch shared that she is planning a Best Buddies holiday get together. Ms. Lewis shared that our music teacher Ms. Groulx will have a first-grade holiday performance at school.

Ms. Beisch motioned to adjourn the meeting, Ms. Precious seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned at 3:01 p.m.
