

- 1. Welcome Ms. Oppy welcomed everyone to the meeting.
- 2. Review of Minutes Ms. Campbell motioned to accept the minutes as written, Ms Hood seconded the motion.
- 3. Old Business We still need a quorum to vote for the SAC funds to be used to purchase phonics kits.
- 4. New Business
  - a. Presentation "How to help your student at home"—Ms. Rant presented home based strategies to help manage behavior at home and creating routines. She discussed creating a positive environment at home by defining expectations and expected and unexpected behaviors. ABC's of behavior antecedent, behavior and consequence. All behavior is a form of communication. Functions of behavior MEATS (medical, escape, attention, tangible and sensory). We can change behavior by teaching replacement behaviors. It is

- important that we respond to behavior not react to the behavior. Ms.

  Rant shared resources for the parents and had fliers and handouts for the different resources.
- b. Smart Bond Update Helen Voyer and Spiros Dimitropoulos from
  the district presented information about the Smartbond process and
