- 1. <u>Welcome</u> Ms. Luckenbach welcomed everyone. Snacks were provided for the group.
- 2. <u>Review of Minutes</u> Ms. Dittmeier made a motion to accept the minutes. Ms. Ramon seconded the motion.
- 3. <u>Title One: Parent Training</u> Our last Title one training is May 17th at 6:30 at Atlantic West. We will put the information on our website and social media. The title one bus will be here. There will be games and lots of resources for the families.
- 4. <u>School Uniforms</u>: <u>Ballots, Voting</u> The ballots were sent home today for unified dress. The voting will continue through this week, one vote per household. We need 66 2/3% to pass the unified dress code. Ballots were also sent home in Spanish and Creole. Results will be announced on May 14th. Ms. Luckenbach will clarify how the votes are counted. Ms. Luckenbach will contact Lashawn Thompson to help determine the number of households at our school.
- 5. <u>SAF Representative</u> Our SAF representative was not in attendance to give an update.
- 6. <u>Principal's Report</u>: This week is Teacher and Staff Appreciation week. Breakfast was provided today by AXA. The PTA will provide lunch on Tuesday. Wednesday, Ms. Eagan and Ms. Lewis will provide coffee.

We are finishing our state testing this week. Third and fourth grade are taking the FSA math this week. First and second grade are taking the primary reading test on Tuesday and Wednesday. Then the teachers will administer any alternative testing as needed.

Next year, Atlantic West will have two Head start classes, one class for 3 year olds and one class for 4 year olds. There will be 18 students in each class with one paraprofessional.

They are ready to break ground on our new marquee.

The last PLCs of the year will focus on planning the quarter 1 UBDs.

The FSA camp went over budget for salaries this year. Ms. Eagan asked the committee to approve \$1,355.00 to cover the additional cost of salaries. Ms. Dittmeier made a motion to approve the funds, Ms. Dejo seconded the motion. Ms. Luckenbach called for a vote. The SAC vote was unanimous to approve the funds.

7. <u>Concerns/Celebrations</u>: Our last exhibit night is coming up on May 24th. Ms. Luckenbach is working on getting additional sponsors and banners for the front of the school. Zuckerelli's restaurant will be our new partner. The Office of Academic Excellence came out to video our STEAM enrichment camp. Ms. Dittmeier announced that AWE placed 4th in the chess competition. Two Atlantic West students came in first place. Ms. Beisch celebrated the recent Parent Resource Fair with many vendors for ESE students. This event was a huge success. This event was for all families in our area. Coconut Creek High School attended the event to promote the Best Buddies program. The Best Buddies program had a Spring Fling at Atlantic West. Their partners at Coconut Creek

High School came to this event. One of our students, who is the best buddies president, is being interviewed tomorrow by students at Coconut Creek High. We are working on awards and celebrations for next year for all clubs.
