



Central Park Elementary School School Advisory Council (SAC) Meeting Minutes November 14, 2018

The Central Park School Advisory Council (SAC) met on November 14, 2018. Lois Wall, SAC Chairperson, called the meeting to order at 8:34 AM.

SAC members in attendance included: Jaime Adamczyk, Jill Carr, Cherise Coleman, Maria Lami-Dozo, Toni Kaiser, Delia Encin, Pamela O'Grady, Tara Slavin, Alexis Russell, Cinthya Dominguez, Anna Middlebrooks, and Lois Wall.

Guests that attended: Carol Saponaro and Kirsten Leith

Mrs. Wall presented the minutes from the October 17, 2018 meeting. Jaime Adamczyk made a motion to approve the minutes. Dr. Jill Carr seconded the motion.

Open SAC/SAF Positions:

- We elected a SAF Chairperson, however, the parent withdrew from the school and is now attending another Broward County Public School. We have sent out information to the community so we can elect a new SAF Chairperson.
- We will also be securing a parent of Hispanic ethnicity, due to a parent resigning because of employment to ensure we maintain compliance for our SAC Composition.

A+ Funds Ballot Results:

- The A+ Ballot was voted on by the staff at Central Park Elementary. The vote took place on Thursday, November 8th. The votes were counted by Mrs. Wall, SAC Chairperson, and Mrs. Hagood-Elliott, BTU Steward.
- Option 1 was voted in by over 51% of the faculty and staff that voted.

Accountability Funds:

 Survey the staff on academic needs to decide how we want to spend the funds. Bring feedback to SAC Committee at next meeting to make decisions for approval.

Committee Updates:

- Reading: Barnes and Noble night will be coming up in February. The reading committee is currently
 working on the activities for this event.
- Math/Science: We had a great turnout on the Family Math/Science Night. The Scientific Method
 projects were phenomenal. The students were able to articulate to their parents how they used the
 Scientific Process for his project. The math center rotations were engaging and the families loved
 participating with their children in the activities.

Principal's Update:

- Thank you to the PTA for a fabulous book fair. We raised over \$5,000.00.
- Fifth grade is currently working on the community service project for the Harvest Drive. Families
 are sending in donations, which will be sent to Plantation High School for distribution.
- Central Park has identified 8 families in need and PTA will be purchasing a turkey for each of the families for pick up on Friday, November 16th.
- Snowflake Wishes distribution begins Thursday, November 15th through Tuesday, November 20th.
 Parents and staff can choose a snowflake off the tree in the front office or when they come through the carpool line. Presents will be given to families in need.
- Teachers in grades 3-5 participated in DBQ (Document Based Questioning) Writing Training last month. Grades 1 and 2 will be participating in the same training in December.

- Science adoption training is this Saturday, November 17th, and Saturday, December 1st. Twenty-two
 teachers will be participating in the trainings. They will be paid a \$15.00 per hour stipend and will
 receive inservice points as well.
- Fifth grade teachers attended a training for two days on Writing Workshop for grades 3-5. Grade 4
 will be attending in January and February. The workshop focus was on craft, structure, and
 elaboration.
- Standards Based Training for Small Group Guided Reading All teachers in grades K-5 will be attending an inservice in January.

Mrs. Martinez, Guidance Counselor, will do a presentation on Sanford Harmony (Social Emotional Learning Program) at the next SAC Meeting.

Next meeting will be Tuesday, December 11, 2018.
