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Central Park Elementary School School Advisory Council (SAC) Meeting Minutes March 20, 2019

The Central Park School Advisory Council (SAC) met on March 20, 2019. Lois Wall, SAC Chairperson, called the meeting to order at 8:34 AM.

SAC members in attendance included: Jaime Adamczyk, Jill Carr, Cherise Coleman, Alejandro Dominguez, Cynthia Dominguez, Maria Lami-Dozo, Delia Encin, Kimberly Hagood-Elliott, Toni Kaiser, Courtney Kirner, Anna Middlebrooks, Pamela O'Grady, Alexis Russell, Tara Slavin, and Lois Wall.

Guests that attended: Kelly Arteaga, Melanie Kashi, and Carol Saponaro.

Mrs. Wall presented the minutes from the February 21, 2019 meeting. Jaime Adamczyk made a motion to approve the minutes. Dr. Jill Carr seconded the motion.

End of Year Testing Dates:

- Mrs. Wall shared the testing dates for FSA grades 3-5 and Primary Reading Assessment grades 1 and 2.
- Promotion criteria is the primary indicator for FSA and Primary Reading Assessment.
- Students who do not meet the primary promotion criteria will be taking alternative assessments for good cause promotion.
- · Students need to be on time for testing and only miss school if absolutely necessary.

School Improvement - Updates for Mid-year Progress:

- Mrs. Wall shared the mid-year reflection at a previous meeting with the SAC committee.
- We are continuing to progress monitor our reading and math interventions.
- Teachers are now beginning their 3rd administration of the Benchmark Assessment Test (BAS).
- Students in LLI are being continually regrouped as needed based on their BAS results.
- Our goal is that every child in school makes a learning gain.

Before & After School Child Care Program Safety Checklist Results:

 Ms. Coleman shared the results from the Safety Checklist. Our Before and After Care Program did very well on this assessment. All indicators on the checklist were marked yes, which means we met the requirements on our safety evaluation.

School-wide Positive Behavior Plan:

- Ms. Coleman shared our School-wide Positive Behavior Plan that the staff developed and voted on by all teachers. To date, there was a total of 9 discipline referrals for this school year and most of these referrals were for unruly disruptive behavior.
- CHAMPS will continue to be our school-wide behavior plan for the 19-20 school year.

Committee Updates:

- Reading/Language Arts: Mrs. Wall shared that we will be doing a reading curriculum night for parents next year to assist with strategies to help their child at home.
- Science: Dr. Carr has been working with the 5th grade teachers to assist with preparing the students for the Science Assessment. She has been reviewing the 3rd and 4th grade standards while the teachers have been instructing the 5th grade standards.
- Math: We are waiting for the results from the Broward County Council of Teachers in Mathematics (BCCTM) Competition that was held on March 9th for our 4th and 5th grade students. As soon as we receive the results, we will share it with the community. Next year, we will be using the Go Math series again since the governor has discontinued Common Core Standards. There is a possibility of not getting new math materials until the 20-21 school year.

Principal's Update:

- School projections were finalized last week for the 2019-2020 school year. This next step in the process will be to build our budget based on the funds for student membership.
- Installation of Aiphone System to control the electric door strike at the front entrance of the campus is in progress. We are now waiting for the District to come out and install the Aiphone System.
- A new camera was installed in the front of the school which now monitors the bus loop, sidewalk going into the front of the school, and both sidewalks on the north and south of the front entrance.
- PTA gave each instructional staff member \$250.00 to purchase items for their classroom.

Next meeting will be Wednesday, May 15, 2019.
