# Reports.

- Reading: No report due to preparation for the Pelican Standard Assessment (PSA) testing

- Science: Ms. Monin reported that all grades are preparing for Science Night and that all grade levels got their boards. She also reported that the Andrew "RED" Harris foundation has donated a set of five "Shark the Clark" books for each Third grade class.
- Writing: Ms. Benedit reported that teachers are happy with progress of students at this time. Fourth graders are writing completely on their own after teachers have modeled and practiced with them previously.
  - Fourth and Fifth graders have been using Document Based Questioning (**DBQ**) and are excited and engaged about using it. DBQ is Social Studies/History based.

### **Principals Report:**

- ➤ Ms. Wagner reported that
  - Pembroke Lakes Elementary has been recognized as a 5-star school. There are only 700 nationwide.
  - The Pembroke Lakes Homeowners Association made a donation to our school which will be used in the area of technology and wanted to express her gratitude.
  - Students took the ELA portion of the PSA last week for the first time. The Broward Standard Assessments (BSA) did not change to paper based. The PSA will be used as a teaching tool as it will provide information on the standards students have mastered and which ones need reteaching. It mocks the FSA, is broken into two days, and paper based. There is more flexibility than BSA and answers are transferred to forms which grades the test for the students providing immediate results and feedback.
  - o This week the Math PSA (Wed and Thurs) will be administered.
  - Code Red drills are being conducted on a monthly basis. Both fire and Code Red drills were held as a cafeteria scenario before the winter holiday. Varied scenario based drills will continue to be conducted throughout the year.
  - February 14 is the commemoration of the MSD incident and named as a day of service and love. All schools are being asked to participate in some way. We will participate in the Flanigan Zone and participate in the community in some way.
  - o Science night is February 6.
  - o Spring Pictures are February 15: no uniforms necessary.
