Objectives: Share information concerning the school.

Call to order: 2:20 pm

Motion to Change Agenda: Add Heather Zardus as the business partner/community representative on the SAC. Danielle Tortorella made Motion, Melissa Gwizdz second. All in Favor.

Minutes: Minutes August 29, 2018 accepted as presented.

Financial Report: Currently \$5480 in accountability funds. Will recheck as may not have received all funds yet.

#### SAC By Laws Approval:

Items to review:

- How long an officer holds their position?
- When will Election of officers occur?
- When will installation of officers occur
- Do we have a chair only or Co-Chairs?

#### Results:

- · Officers hold their position for 1 school year.
- Elections of officer will occur at the meeting in May.
- Installation of officers is at the first meeting of the school year following elections.
- Our SAC will have co-chairs.

Beth Fazio made a motion to accept the By-laws, Valerie Leath second, all in favor and accepted.

#### SRO Report:

There is an SRO assigned to every school and there is an extra Full Time Police officer assigned to every high school. If there will be trainings, there will be an extra officer to cover.

Bleed Control kit training will be soon. Goodman has an email and will follow up.

#### A+ Funds:

- Can be used for:
  - Bonuses for staff
  - Equipment and supplies
  - Temporary staff
- Process: SAC makes proposals, then current staff members have 3 days to vote by ballot. Ballot must
  include an option of "None of the above" and up to 2 other options. Must have 50% or more to approve one
  option. SAC to reconvene and redo ballot if none of the options get more than 50%
- Last winning proposal was 100% of A+ funds will be used for equal bonuses for all staff members.
- Discussion:
  - Deanna asked if there was a need for equipment & Supplies. Ms. Geraine said always a need, but last proposal was the only one that passed.
  - Heather asked about need for temporary staff? Geraine said typically we've used accountability funds for that.
  - Valerie asked will new employees be eligible for funds. Ms. Nixon answered that those who worked last year as staff are eligible.
  - Carli asked if interim subs who covered 7 teachers on maternity leave were eligible. Ms. Geraine said if they were hired as employees, and in same position, yes.

#### · Wording on Ballot:

For all proposals, to be eligible to receive A+ dollars, you must have worked one day more than one half of your calendar year (including maternity/medical/family leave days) at Westchester Elementary during the 2017-2018 school year beginning July 1, 2017 and ending June 30, 2018.

For all proposals, the amount received by all eligible personnel will be prorated according to the time worked during the 2017-2018 school year with the exception of maternity/medical/family leave.

Motion by Mary Beth Gebbia to accept this wording, second be Valerie Leath. 16 in favor, 1 abstained, motion passed.
