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### School Advisory Council (SAC) Meeting Agenda Minutes

Thursday, January 24, 2019 5:30 p.m.

- Welcome

1. Meeting was called to order at 5:35pm

- Review November minutes

Motion to accept the minutes : Nancy Tillman

Vote: There was a unanimous vote to accept November's minutes.

- After-School Program Options

Review of Afterschool information: Ms. Plummer explained the JCC program and also allowed for the review of other afterschool programs by those present to make a decision regarding keeping the present afterschool care program or whether to vote for another. After a review of the presented material, there was a motion to keep the current afterschool care program – JCC.

Vote: There was a unanimous vote to continue with the current JCC afterschool care program. The vote was carried out by stating "yes" or "no".

- 21st Century Grant (After-School Enrichment)

Provides daily enrichment for students, for third to fifth grade from 2p.m. – 5p.m. Students rotate between three teachers at a time. Grant lasts until July. Areas include: Drama, Dance, Science, Math, and Reading. A parent who was in agreement with the program, stated, "The program attends to the whole child. They need that extra part of school that is not so tedious and academic". JCC is currently working with Dr. Crowle to get a supper program to enhance this enrichment program

- School Safety

Dr. Crowle: Thanked the parents for support with presenting I.D.'s and being patient with enforcing Single point of entry. She also added:

Each classroom will have a designated 'safe space'. At Morrow the students know where to go for the 'safe space'. We will continue to conduct drills in a timely manner. Dr. Crowle is always available for comments and questions.

- 2019-2020 school calendar reviewed with those present at meeting. The school calendar is based on the number of days students and staff are absent. For the 2019 – 2020 School Calendar, school restarts on August 7<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

- SMART Bond

Dr. Crowle informed those present that a note will be sent home. The vote on certain items will need to be revisited. Specific items that will be revisited: a) Murals and b) playground. Dr. Crowle informed those present that not enough money was available for the playground. During next SAC meeting, it will be decided what to do with remaining funds. Other funds from the SMART Bond were used for computers, I-PADS, Broadcast system, and speakers in the cafeteria

Concern: Speakers are needed in hallway

Dr. Crowle informed those present that a member from the district will also be present to discuss the SMART Bond. Other funds from the SMART Bond will be used to complete the media center, install a sprinkler system. The bid has already been approved for installation of the sprinkler system. A wheelchair lift is also to be installed in the cafeteria. We are awaiting timeline. Work will be started in March and will take place over the summer and is to be completed before school resumes.

- New Business

Title one Parent Survey. District collect 70 surveys. District report results will be available in February. Will be discussed at SAC

- Open Forum/Parental Input: The floor was open for parental input

- A parent explained that she received a District letter (reading level), had discrepancy regarding levels. The Reading Coach, Ms. Mason explained the difference in possible discrepancy level.

- Parent: "Does the result go in their file?"

Dr. Crowle explained that it does not go in the student's file. Dr. Crowle explained the expected criteria for promotion and encouraged the parent to confer with the teacher.

Ms. Campbell ( teacher) asked: "How are we doing with the MSD recommendations?"

Dr. Crowle, responded that we are on target and doing well. On the playground, everyone should have access to a radio

Ms. Campbell: "Will there be speakers installed in the hallways?"

Dr. Crowle: They are working on that, cameras have been installed and are being monitored

Ms. Campbell asked, "Are our cameras on real-time?"

Dr. Crowle responded that the cameras are on real-time

- Adjourn: There was a motion to adjourn the SAC meeting by Kim Reneau and seconded by Ms. Nancy Tillman . The next date for SAC is scheduled for February 19<sup>th</sup>, 2019, but was adjusted to February 5<sup>th</sup>, 2019 (Math Night)
