- **21st Century After-School Program Updates**
 - Currently membership of 79
 - Grant funded, holds 80 students K-5
 - Students are given a mid-year checkpoint- Food and Nutrition Assessments
 - 5-year grant including the summer program from 8am – 4pm
 - Ms. Tucker will be running the summer program and will contact any new parents.
 - (we now have 40 additional applicants)
 - There will be a new application for the new school year (August)
 - Field trips on Fridays, lunch is provided
 - JCC will be operating as well during the summer
 - Parent Question— Is there a waiting list?

 - **Parent Questions:**
 - Is there presently a date for the upcoming school year's FSA

 - How do students know what the rules are?
 - Feedback to parent questions provided by Ms. Dowe, Assistant Principal Brightman, and Ms. Mason, Literacy Coach.
- **School-wide positive Behavior Plan**
 - Passed out Draft for Review Assistant Principal Brightman
 - Is a cooperative effort between all stakeholders
 - Mr. Brightman encouraged those present to share feedback
- **Smart Bond Updates**
 - Mr. Brightman projected a diagram of where the school plans to place speakers in order to enhance the sound system of school which in turn increases the school's safety.
 - Question: why does the district handle this type of issue with the speaker system? Why doesn't Facilities handle this issue?
 - Dr. Crowle explained that it was suggested that the Smart Bond leftover funds of \$21,000 be used for the speakers through SAC. Dr. Crowle also clarified that it is not Accountability funds but SMART Bond funds that are being used.
- **Florida Standards Review**
 - 2019-2020 Florida Standards are available for critique and feedback
 - Mrs. Plummer provided written instructions on how to provide the feedback
