Morrow's SAC Meeting Minutes

8/30/2018

- Welcome
  - Dr. Crowle welcomed all present. She informed parents of recent changes and information.
  - Dr. Crowle opened the floor for nominations for the 2018-2019 PTA
  - The following were nominated for President, Treasurer, and Secretary respectively:

  - There was a motion to close the nominations which was seconded by Kim Reneau.
  - Dr. Crowle then introduced Mr. Brightman our Assistant Principal, who then addressed the parents and assured them of his support.
  - SAC Membership/Election
    - Dr. Crowle introduced Mr. Vilus as last year's SAC Chair who then opened the floor for nominations for the 2018-19 school year.
    - Mr. Vilus opened the floor for nominations for SAC Chair/2 Co-chairs
    - Nominations :

      - Ms. Dove & Ms. Plummer were nominated as SAC Co-Chairs
      - Nominations for Secretary

        - Ms. Brazle
        - 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ms. Plummer
      - Ms. Dove, Ms. Plummer and Ms. Brazle were voted as SAC Co-Chairs and Secretary respectively for 2018-19 School Year
    - SAC Bylaws
      - Mr. Vilus invited those present to review the SAC bylaws
      - Ms. Plummer reviewed the Articles of bylaws with those present
      - A vote was taken on the bylaws led by Mr. Vilus
      - Motion to accept bylaws -Kim Reneau which was seconded by Ms. Mason. There was then a vote to accept the by-laws (unanimous)
    - SIP Plan
      - 2018-2019 SIP plan was reviewed and parental input was requested. There were no suggestions at this time. Dr. Crowle informed parents that their input is always welcome throughout the year.
