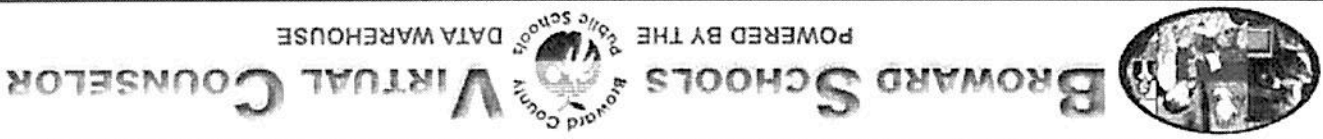

- **Welcome**
 - Dr. Crowle welcomed all present
- **Review of August meeting Minutes**
 - Dr. Crowle invited those present to review the minutes
 - Motion to accept the minutes
 - Correction- Misspelling
 - Motion to accept the minutes with noted changes-Ms. Nancy Tilman
 - 2nd by Ms. Reneau
- **SAC Officers Introduction**
 - The 2018-19 SAC officers introduced themselves to those present.
- **Review of School Improvement Plan (SIP 18-19)**
 - Dr. Crowle explained that parent input plays a vital part in developing the SIP plan. She explained that the focus was on students completing their homework, reading daily and rigor of the standards.
- **School-Wide Positive Behavior Plan**
 - Ms. Dove introduced Mr. Brightman who then reviewed the School-Wide Positive Behavior Plan with those present.
 - He explained that the School-Wide Positive Behavior Plan helps develop expectations and create rules for better behavior of students and invited parents to contribute their input. Mr. Brightman also informed parents the behavior plan is also available on Morrow school's website.
 - Mr. Brightman also informed parents that our teachers are equipped with related lessons to assist with increasing positive behavior.
- **Parental Input in school programs and activities**
 - Dr. Crowle encouraged parents to come out and become involved
- **Family and Community Engagement Plan(F.A.C.E.)**
 - Dr. Crowle explained to parents the Family and Community Engagement plan and explained to parents the importance of having involvement and how working together with the school and community can ensure a more successful student.
- **School-Parent Compact**
 - Copies of the School Parent compact were given out to parents for review and parents were invited to make suggestions to improve the School Parent Compact
- **MyOn, I-Ready and Reflex Math**
 - Dr. Crowle explained MyOn, I-Ready and Reflex math programs and reminded parents that these programs are available to students at home. She also reminded parents that any questions about the programs can be addressed by their child's teacher.
- **Safety Updates**
 - Dr. Crowle informed parents that we have now been assigned a School Guardian, Mr. Tarbox whose responsibility it is to protect and minimize potential disruptions to our campus. Mr. Tarbox, a retired police officer comes to our school with many years of experience.

Dr. Crowle informed parents that even though Officer Sheridan is no longer with us our school will continue to have a School Resource Officer (SRO) once or twice a week.

Accountability Funds

- Our school last year was allocated \$2,300 in funds which was used to have the computer lab open to students from 2:00pm – 3:00pm
- The floor was opened for suggestions or changes on how to use the funds for this school year, invited by Ms. Plummer, our Co-SAC Chair.
- Parents were given the option of using the funds for the use of technology. The funds are used to pay the non-instructional
- There was a motion by Ms. Plummer and seconded by S. Clarke (Parent) to use the funds to have the computer lab available to students from 2:00p.m. – 3:00pm 2 days per week.
- The vote was unanimous.

Methods of Communication

- Ms. Dove provided the parents with methods of communication should any parent have a suggestion or concern. She informed parents that they could contact the school via phone, school website, or school's newsletter. Ms. Dove also reminded parents that contact could be made through their child's teacher. She reminded parents to check their child's folder for upcoming activities or any communication.
- Dr. Crowle reminded parents of the importance of their involvement in the RTI process.
- Mrs. Nguyen informed parents that they would be invited to be a part of the RTI team/process either by herself or another member of the ESE team. A letter will be sent home to parents to inform them. Mrs. Nguyen also reminded parents of the open-door policy.

PARENT INPUT

- During the SAC a parent made a statement:
Parent: "I am not sure about what is going on during the SAC meetings."
Parent: "Is there someone specific to call or speak with?"
 - The parent sought clarification and asked for communication ahead of time as it would pertain to an upcoming SAC meeting.
 - Dr. Crowle informed the parent of several avenues of communication including the communication forms located in the front office in the event that someone might not be readily available. Dr. Crowle assured the parent that a copy of the agenda would be sent out prior to a SAC meeting.
 - Mrs. Plummer, our Co-SAC Chair also suggested to the parent to submit an email address so that the agenda could be emailed to the parent.
 - Mrs. Plummer, informed those present that representation in the following areas is needed and asked for volunteers to fill these positions: ESE, Gifted, Title one, and SAF. She also announced an upcoming Title 1 parent training. Mrs. Plummer also reminded parents of the importance of attending Title 1 meetings and the wealth of pertinent information that is available at these meetings. She urged them to attend.
 - There was a motion to adjourn the SAC meeting by Ms. Mason which was then seconded by Crystal Barnes (parent), followed by a unanimous vote.
