 - Ms. Dowe welcomed everyone to the SAC meeting and Morrow's Fall Family Night
- Review September minutes
 - Ms. Dowe invited all present to review the SAC minutes from the previous meeting.
 - There was a motion to approve the minutes by Ms. Tillman and seconded by Ms.
 Plummer
 - There was a unanimous vote to accept the SAC Minutes
- Review of School Improvement Plan (SIP)
 - Ms. Dowe directed those present to review the SIP for the 2018-19 school year (attachment)
 - Ms. Dowe reminded parents that the SIP document is a live document and invited suggestions. She also reminded those present on how to access the SIP on the school's website for a more comprehensive review.
 - Dr. Crowle addressed items that are observed via the School Improvement Plan.
 She explained the importance of attendance and how the SIP is used to assist monitor and improve it. She mentioned looking for warning signs through patterns of attendance and making plans to stay ahead.

- Dr. Crowle also reminded parents that frequent early sign-outs can also become an area of concern.
