- Welcome
 - Ms. Dowe welcomed everyone to the SAC meeting and Morrow's Fall Family Night
- Review September minutes
 - Ms. Dowe invited all present to review the SAC minutes from the previous meeting.
 - There was a motion to approve the minutes by Ms. Tillman and seconded by Ms. Plummer
 - There was a unanimous vote to accept the SAC Minutes
- Review of School Improvement Plan (SIP)
 - Ms. Dowe directed those present to review the SIP for the 2018-19 school year (attachment)
 - Ms. Dowe reminded parents that the SIP document is a live document and invited suggestions. She also reminded those present on how to access the SIP on the school's website for a more comprehensive review.
 - Dr. Crowle addressed items that are observed via the School Improvement Plan. She explained the importance of attendance and how the SIP is used to assist monitor and improve it. She mentioned looking for warning signs through patterns of attendance and making plans to stay ahead.

- Dr. Crowle also reminded parents that frequent early sign-outs can also become an area of concern.
 - Parent suggested that we should have access to previous years of absences to measure progress and plan for improvement.
 - Parent: Did we receive A plus funds for this year?
 - Dr. Crowle: “No”
- Suggestions/Input for SIP
 - Safety Updates
 - Sign in with your id
 - We will continue to conduct safety drills. A parent link will be sent out as a reminder.
 - We will continue to conduct one fire drill and one safety drill per month.
 - Positive Behavior Intervention School (PBIS)
 - The Positive Behavior Intervention School plan assists Morrow in approaching behavior in a positive manner.
 - Student Code of Conduct
 - Discipline Matrix
 - Copies are available on line
 - Florida Standards Assessments (FSA)
 - The FSA is administered in grades 3, 4, and 5
 - Dr. Crowle informed parents of the dates for the Assessments and reminded parents of the importance of passing the Third grade
 - FLDOE Parent Portal
 - Information about Progress Reports
 - Dr, Crowle informed the parents of the dates for the report cards
 - Promotion Criteria, Progress Monitoring Plan (PMPs)
 - Dr. Crowle reviewed with parents the importance of the PMP. She also informed parents that if their child is on a PMP, it would be marked on the report card and parents would also receive a letter informing them.
 - Dr. Crowle reviewed the promotion criteria with parents
 - Response to Intervention (RtI)
 - According to Ms. Nguyen parents have been responding positively to the RTI process.
 - Social and Emotional Learning (SEL)
 - Ms. Nguyen addressed Social Emotional Learning with those present.
 - She reminded parents that it is covered by insurance and grants are available
 - Ms. Nguyen will make referrals as necessary
 - Vouchers are available for other types of testing such as hearing and vision
 - Ms. Nguyen encouraged parents to contact her should questions arise.

- Parent Academy
 - Ms. Plummer our SAC Co-Chair discussed Parent Academy and its advantages.
 - Parent Academy assists parents with ways in which they can positively better their child's behavior
 - Academy is quite effective and informative
 - Ms. Plummer encouraged everyone to come out to the Parent Academy
