i. Meeting called to order

a. The meeting was called to order at 2:33 p.m.

ii. Approval of February 20, 2019 Minutes

a. Minutes from December 12th, 2018 were approved by Angela Clark.

iii. 2019-2020 SAC Chair/Co-Chair

a. Mr. Brown informed the committee that according to the By-Laws, the positions for SAC Chair and Co-Chair are for 2-year terms. These terms can be amended pending a vote from the committee. Mr. Brown and Mrs. Groudan have completed their 2-year terms. These positions will need to be filled for the 2019-2020 school year.

iv. 2018-2019 Title I Annual Evaluation Results

Mr. Brown informed the committee of the following results:

- a. Ramblewood received 253 responses
- b. Ramblewood received the highest percentages on the following questions: #8 (90%) "I receive information from my child's school how to work with teachers to help my child succeed."

#1 (86%) – "I often receive information from my child's school about what the school teachers my child."

#10 (86%) "I receive information about working with teachers to improve my child's achievement."

- c. Ramblewood received the lowest scores on the following questions:
 - #25 (29%) "I have asked for specific activities, meetings, or materials from my child's school."
 - # 18 (28%) "My child's school has asked my advice on how they can best teach my child.
 - #14 (21%) "I went to one or more meetings, trainings, events on the topic of using materials to best teach my child.
- d. Debbie Bowers had the following suggestions for improving parent survey responses:
 - 1) Provide computers for parents to utilize during Before/After Care.
 - 2) Provide incentives for parents (Raffles, Holiday Givaways, etc)
 - 3) Provide food during various school events

v. Smart Bond Updates (per Marlene Ghaby)

- a. M. Ghaby is following up with the playground vendor for permitting and waiting on permit submittal.
- b. The marquee sign is currently in fabrication.

vi. Safety/Security
