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# Riverglades Elementary School Advisory Council Meeting Minutes January 28, 2019

Attendance: attached. We have a quorum.

Call to Order:

A meeting of the Riverglades Elementary School Advisory Council was called to order by Mrs. Bevins at 9:55am. Secretary, Diane Jordan recorded the minutes for this meeting.

Minutes:

Elisha Johnson motioned to approve the minutes of November 26, 2018. Jody King seconded the motion. A vote was taken. Motion outcome: The minutes were approved as presented.

After School Child Care Quality Standards Assessment Results: An inspection of our After School Care Program was conducted. Our scores were exceptional. There were only a couple of minor adjustments that needed to be made. On the day of the inspection, 262 students were present, and there are 281 students enrolled in the program.

Safety Updates: Mrs. Seltzer reported on Safer Spaces: Riverglades has had safety procedures in place for some time. Now it is District Policy, with some of the names changing and the pictures will change. Procedures we have been already been doing will continue with just a few tweaks. She also explained that when we conduct a drill, we start on a Code Yellow then move to Code Red. There is a process that the Safe Team follows to account for each and every student during a Code.

SIP - Developing: Mrs. Seltzer shared that  $3^{rd}-5^{th}$  completed the BAS for ELA and Math and only  $5^{th}$  grade will be finishing up with science this week. The results the teachers analyze will indicate whether students are on track for proficiency on the FSA. Our support reading teacher, Mrs. Mann will be providing assistance for those students in need.

Mr. Duhart reported that our Attendance Plan for our School Improvement Plan was reviewed. In the area of our goal, we needed to make an adjustment. The remainder of the plan scored top marks.

Mrs. Seltzer announced that Mrs. Dockswell retired, and Mrs. Lauren Arlt is now our ESE Specialist.

Under the direction of Mrs. Mason and Mrs. Lettman, the Robotics Club participated in a competition this weekend. Our students made it to the finals and came home with The Energy Award for displaying great sportsmanship. Congrats to them.

Questions, concerns, and ideas: A parent voiced a concern about a situation in the cafeteria involving her child being removed from his class table and seated at an alternative table. Mrs. Seltzer explained about our School Wide Positive Behavior Plan. Mrs. Bevins shared her follow up lesson and parent communication that addressed cafeteria behavior. A discussion of cafeteria behavior procedures followed.

Meeting adjourned 10:30am
