Meeting was called to order at 2:20.

New member, Mina Rosaria Mastandrea Capocefalo as installed as our ESOL rep. Motion to approved by Ms. Diaz, seconded by Ms. Campos.

Topics/Questions parents have:

Campus Security- parents want to know why it is taking so long to get the buzzer on the front door. Parents are concerned because the campus is so spread out and the question is how to make it secure. SRO spoke about how there is discussion on how to make sure fences are always secure and they are working on the situation with the buzzer. The county is fixing the door and PTA will be voting on the buzzer (striker). Ms. Masseria informed us that Mr. Runcie discussed security at a recent meeting and it is going to take time. The school district is working on cameras, radios and repeaters for every school. Ms. Marzan questioned internal securing and whether our school counselor is at Country Isles full time. Ms. Cox responded that the trained school counselor is on campus full-time and that the leadership team has also been trained on specific protocols regarding what to do in the event of a threat. The detective from SIU will be here in February to observe a drill and review safety procedures with all staff members. Over the summer the police and fire departments looked at the school and made recommendations. It is noted that parents are concerned about the fence behind the third grade building.

FSA Performance- BSA started today and it mirrors the FSA for grades 3-5. The second i-Ready Diagnostic was completed in December. At this time, administration and teachers are looking at all of the data and making recommendations. Considering FSA camps in math this year. It is not decided how students will be selected for FSA camps. Camps would take place from Mid-February until the end of April. Fifth grade is using Science Boot Camp, which is new to Country Isles this year.

Extracurricular Programs/Heron Hobbies- Heron Hobbies in the spring will depend on FSA camps. Look into offering extra activities in aftercare. Ms. Marzan suggested a cursive club or book buddies.

BTU News- Contracts expired in June. They are working without a contract at this time. It is still in negotiations.
