#### **II. Approval of Minutes from February Meeting**

#### **III. School Improvement Behavior Plan- School-wide Positive Behavior Plan**

This year was Drive to do the Right Thing (certificates and brag tags distributed with report cards)

The top 3 school-wide locations included:

Therefore, for the 2019-2020 school year, the focus will be on the cafeteria.
