**Call to Order:**

A meeting of the Riverside Elementary's School Advisory Council was held in the Media Center on January 23, 2019. Chair Tamayo called the meeting to order at 6:39 PM. Taylor D'Elia will record minutes for this meeting.

**Minutes:**

Barrett Goldman Motions to approve the minutes of November 26, 2018. No corrections were made to the minutes. Motion seconded by Vonda Allen. Minutes were approved unanimously by the SAC committee.

**Principal's Report:**

1. **Upcoming enrichment camp available for English Language Learners-** We applied for a grant. This program helps bridge the language gap for English Language Learners. This program will target 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> graders that can benefit from the program.
2. **Safety and Security-** team leaders walked the campus and reviewed evacuation routes. Developed multiple evacuation routines. Fence is being put in around the perimeter of the school. Will move forward and review procedures with entire staff.
3. **February 14-** Commemoration event focused on love, kindness, and service. Valentine's Day activities will be held the Friday before 2/8. We are working with local community businesses for this event. Moment of silence will be held at 10:17 AM. There will now be a department of school safety with a new chief of safety and security.
4. **Iready data-** 88% proficiency in reading and 62% in math. This is higher than district averages. Working with iready data to analyze every student's data grades 3-5 into 4 quadrants to help with instructional grouping.

**Old Business:**

SMART School Choice Enhancement Update- We agreed to look into new computers, and two half courts.

PA System- District has said they will install an outdoor PA System, but it may be a year and a half before it will be installed. Looking into confirmation of this information to influence the creation of the sample ballots.

Create a Ballot- Ballot will be created at the next SAC meeting. At least 2 sample ballots will be presented at the next meeting.

New Computers \$239 each- We will decide how many computers needed based on other items on the ballot.
