True Instruction, not just practice

Best practice lessons are aligned to the Fl. Standards

Students should only go on 45 minutes per week per subject!

Online Instruction Reports (Class) monitored by the teacher for lessons passed

Student Dashboard: Pick Reading or Math, character, and theme

- B. The games are there for reinforcement (90 seconds), same as taking a break
- C. Won't earn coins if the next three lessons aren't passed.
- D. Length of lessons vary on grade level

Elementary Mathematics (GoMath!)

- Electronic book (eBook) which includes an **EXTENSIVE** collection of resources including:
- English-language learner (ELL) guides
- Mega Math – Additional lesson practice using engaging audio and animation activities
- Intensive Intervention Skill Packs – Review work for target skills that are a significant struggle
- iTools – virtual manipulatives that help students model and discuss problems
- Concept Readers – Leveled short stories that that help build comprehension and math vocabulary
- Practice Book – Next grade level practice for slightly advanced students
- Reteach SE – Short worksheets that focus in on grade level skills that might need more reinforcement
- Strategic Intervention Activity Guide – Review pages to build understanding when struggling
- Chapter Resources – Practice book, practice assessments, student edition, enrich, reteach, etc....

Elementary Science (STEMScopes & Science A-Z)

- Science A-Z – Multilevel informational texts to support grade level concept understanding (Must select Science A-Z tab in top left corner and not leave on the default Learning A-Z)
- STEMScopes Grade level site, where teachers may have assigned material
- STEMScopes Student eBook grade level site takes you to modules of all the major grade level topics with resources including:
 - Explore activities – hands-on activities to help understand concept
 - Picture vocabulary cards
 - Reading about the science concept
 - Math and engineering connections
 - Short videos on the concept
 - Review games to prepare for assessments
 - Intervention and acceleration practice pages

Elementary Social Studies (Document Based Questions or DBQ 4/5)

- 4th grade DBQ: Florida
- 5th grade DBQ: American History

Library/Media Resources, which is also located in the resource folder in Canvas (passwords are need and are available on the site)

- **Destiny Online Library Catalog** - Search Coral Park's library collection for print and digital resources.
- **Britannica School Online Encyclopedia** - This online encyclopedia provides resources for students at the elementary school level.
- **Gale Online Databases and eBooks** – Will bring students to **Kids InfoBits**, a database of easy to use digital resources that are *age-appropriate*. It provides full-text magazine and newspaper articles, biographies, books, and pictures exploring a broad range of curriculum topics.
- **ProQuest SIRS Databases** – Brings students to **SIRS Discoverer**, similar to Gale/Kids InfoBits, but includes vetted age-appropriate websites and is Lexile measured to accommodate all reading levels.
- **TumbleBook Library** – Database of over a 1,000 e-book picture books and chapter books for grades k-6. Children can read the story themselves or choose to follow along as it's read to them. Also Includes National Geographic videos, graphic novels, and books in Spanish and French

Other Technology Tools: Student access via listed app from their Canvas Launch Pad

- Learning.com – Digital literacy tools that provide practice with keyboarding skills, word processing skills, online safety, and presentation building.
- Newsela - Current news articles that help build reading comprehension and strengthen student writing. Newsela News articles provide multiple perspectives, current insights, timely information and global news on a variety of topics.
- Discovery Education – a digital media library including videos, short reading passages, and pod cast that support understanding of the curriculum for multiple learning styles.
- Chess4Life – Students can learn how to play chess
- Code.org – Students can begin to learn how to make their own games, apps, and computer drawings.
- Office365 – Access to Online versions of Microsoft Word, PowerPoint, Excel, and OneNote.
