

Welcome

The meeting was called to Order at 5:04 pm by Mr. Godoy.

SAC Updates - Mr. Godoy

Mr. Godoy presented the school data from last year's testing and how school grades are assigned. Sandpiper's lowest quartile did not make learning gains last year, so the school grade dropped to a "C". Strategies are in place to help our students make learning gains. These include:

ELA - to strengthen literacy at all levels is our goal. Accelerated Reader is being used to monitor comprehension. Classes are also having intervention groups, and "walk to read" groups.

Math - Reflex math is being used to help reinforce math facts. Classes have intervention groups.

Science - Sandpiper made good progress in science last year. Classes will use a science room for hands on projects and Canvas for videos of demonstrations.

Writing - 4th and 5th grades have started writing seminars with Ms. Emery.

SAC has accountability funds that can help with curriculum as it becomes necessary.

Guidance Office - Ms. Molinelli

Ms. Molinelli spoke about Multi-tiers System of Support/Response to Intervention (MTSS/RTI) and how it is applied and used for student success. She also explained how Social Emotional Learning (SEL) competencies are being integrated into the classroom and modeled.

Title 1 - Ms. Shaffer

Ms. Shaffer provided copies of our Title 1 Plan and our Parent and Family Engagement Plan for 2018-2019. She explained what Title 1 provides and how we document what is done with the additional funding. She asked for parent representatives for Title 1 meetings and seminars. Parents and staff were asked to review the plans and bring comments to the next meeting.

Principal's Update - Ms. LaChance

Ms. LaChance explained the new science curriculum (Stemscopes, materials kits, and new science library for each class). Training is ongoing for teachers.

SAF Updates - Ms. R-Love

Central Area Advisory is meeting tonight - will bring updates to the next meeting. Ms. R-Love explained SAF and how parents can participate.

Mr. Godoy mentioned that the Sandpiper Borders Family Night is tentatively scheduled for December 13, so the December meeting may be changed to the 12th.
