Equity Committee Updates:

We began our Equity Committee this year and have a dedicated team. So far, we have participated in the 2nd grade Cultural Awareness Day and Inclusive Schools Week. We have spread Inclusive Schools Week across a couple of months. We also put together our Kaleidoscope of Friends. Every class was asked to take a colorful square and decorate it according to what inclusion means to them. It is displayed in the cafeteria. We are also working on a sensory walk. This will be a designated area where kids can engage in sensory activities as a break. We are planning where to put our first one, and it will most likely be in the Kindergarten pod.

PTO Updates:

We did well on Bingo Night and made around \$4,000. Yearbooks sales are starting this week, and the next PTO meeting is 2/22. Bookfair is also coming up. Dress Down Day is 3/18 and Kindergarten Round Up is 4/10. We are thinking about having flyers at the Kindergarten Round Up for our Jersey Johns fundraiser. A monetary contribution to a front door buzzer is being considered as the 5th grade "beautification" project. 5th Grade's theme for the end of year celebrations is oceans.

19 Sports is doing great and we're happy to be here!

IZone Report:

Kendall Gigliotti was not present

Principal's Report:

Parents have expressed concerns about lessened parent involvement on campus. The main complaint is that we are pushing parents out. Our priority is to protect the students. Angela shared that several ESOL parents are upset about not being able to attend the Honor Roll assembly. Ms. Borowski shared that students

love the Honor Roll assembly. We are taking less class time and keeping the students safe. Administration spoke with other schools in the area and found that some schools have large celebrations, and some schools do nothing at all until the end of the year. We did not delineate between A and A/B honor roll initially, and we are thinking about using "brag tags" that say A or A/B honor roll. We also have more control over what happens during the celebration and we can actively keep an eye on all the students.

Summer Camp is something Silver Ridge has done every year for a while. We use the funds raised during summer camp to put toward our school. About five years ago, the district began to take 15% off the top of the money raised. This year we were projected to make \$22,000 after giving the 15%. We discovered the district has added another 15% off the top for "fringe". This was then changed to taking 15% off the salaries for summer camp rather than off the top. Some schools make a lot more money than we do, but we make less due to the large number of field trips. A lot of schools are opting out because of having to pay so much to the district. Ms. Borowski asked the district for a run down of where our money is going. We are waiting to hear back. Ms. Borowski has asked SAC to look at the run down when it is provided, have a discussion, and decide what Silver Ridge will do for camp this year. Leslie Balding inquired where the money taken from Summer Camp is going. Ms. Borowski is going to find get further information and share it with the SAC team and stakeholders.

Safety:

We discussed what the 5th Grade graduation will look like. We have been given permission to hold events with parents in attendance at the end of the year. We will have extra security and parents will not be allowed to exit the cafeteria and go into the school for any reason.

Data Review:

BSA testing just wrapped up. The teams are going over the data. The results are provided in a way that shows standards broken down so that teachers know which standards to work on and share best practices in those areas. iReady diagnostic information is also being used to compare the results of the diagnostic to how students do on the FSA.

School Improvement Plan

- Review BPIE: We just completed the 2019 BPIE. Schools complete the BPIE every 3 years. Overall, we are doing very well! We are considered a model school for inclusion in the state of Florida. The kids benefit from the inclusive practices we have put in place, namely the push-in model.
- eProve survey window (3/4-4/4): iPads will be placed in the front office so we can ask parents to fill out the survey and meet our parent participation quota. Students in grades 3-5 will be taking the survey in their STEM special. Teacher will also take the survey.
