- Principal's Report
  - Mrs. Borowski asked the SAC Committee and guests if anyone has any concerns or questions regarding safety. We have spoken about the new Honor Roll procedures and the SAC Committee is in agreement about how the Honor Roll celebration has been changed.
- Safety
  - SAC meetings are a place for safety and security concerns to be brought to the attention of the leadership team and the SAC committee.
  - Events (i.e. 5<sup>th</sup> grade graduation) will be held with the cafeteria being "locked in", which means guests will be confined to the cafeteria and will not be allowed on any other part of the campus. We will be collecting RSVPs for the 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Talent Show to keep the crowd smaller. Parents will be able to attend one day of the talent show.

- PTO has purchased an intercom/buzzer system for the front office door that will be installed very soon.
  - Mrs. Borowski has requested additional gates/fences be installed. At this time, there is no mandate from the county that the school be completely enclosed by a gate/fence.
- Data Review
  - ESSA Update: The “Every Student Succeeds Act” is being implemented in Florida as of September 2018. Data is collected and analyzed by categories, and based on the results, provided additional supports in needed areas. Subgroups include: Major ethnic group (broken down by group), students with disabilities, English Language Learners, and economically disadvantaged students. If any of the subgroups drop below 41 points, the school will move into a Tier 2, and later, Tier 3. Three years are provided to improve the subgroup until the school is put on a plan for improvement. Universal supports (Tier 1) are provided to all schools. Silver Ridge does not have any underperforming subgroups. Universally, Broward County underperforms the most in the area of Students with Disabilities. As compared to the entire county, Silver Ridge does better in this area than about 92% of the schools in Broward.
- School Improvement Plan
  - Communication/Location: The School Improvement Plan can be found on our school’s website. If you hover “Our School” tab, and then click on the School Advisory Council tab, scroll all the way down, and click on the link provided. It can also be found under “Quick Links”. The School Improvement Plan is presented in the form of a website and is not available to be viewed or downloaded as a PDF. The SIP was briefly reviewed. If anyone needs help locating the SIP please contact the school.
  - eProve Surveys: We are working on collecting parent, student, and teacher responses. Students will complete the survey in STEM with Ms. Cross, and made iPads available to parents picking their children up from aftercare if they wanted to take the survey.
