 - Call to order 2:26
- Approval of March minutes
 - Motion: Charlene Walbroehl
 - Second: Darlene Giol
- Equity Committee Updates: see SPBP notes in Principal's Report. Self-regulation has been an issue. Working on a sensory walk pending AC repair schedule this summer.
- PTO Updates: In the nomination state of elections for 2019-2020 school year. Honor Roll 4/26, Spring Pictures 4/29, Teacher Appreciation Week lunch is being planned for 5/10, PTO meeting is 5/23@ 6:00, yearbooks released 5/24.
- Partnership Report: Everything is great! Question raised about possible career day at Silver Ridge; team liked the idea and it will be discussed with administration.
- IZone Report: nothing to report
- Principal's Report
 - Positive Behavior Support Plan (PBSP) for 2019-2020 school year is almost complete. We will continue to focus on being Respectful, Responsible, and Resourceful with Leading the Way tickets as a reward. Cafeteria, recess, and hallways are areas of highest behavioral incidents. A more visual chart will be posted in the cafeteria to monitor number of good (green cone) days and class rewards will be awarded. Reward may be choosing seats in cafeteria versus assigned seating after good behavior days. Tickets given out per classroom will also be monitored to encourage more teachers to use the system consistently. Number of referrals has increased but very few students are receiving referrals (i.e., some students receive multiple); approximately 30 students (3% of school) have received referrals. Behavior plans and interventions are put in place. Broken down by race, gender, etc. (see report). SAC team supports the plan in place.
 - SMART Bond: we have vendor, schedule will be presented before the end of the year, project will likely conclude in 2/2020. School and teachers are being prepared and temporary evacuations (3 rooms at a time) may occur as projects occur; portables will be set up as rotating classrooms. Contracted companies are hired by the district: they are badged and have set walking paths so that interactions with students do not occur.
- Safety: Any concerns?
 - No concerns raised by the team. Updates will continue to be shared at SAC and PTO meetings.
 - New buzzer system is being fitted for the front entrance and office is preparing.
- Data Review: first round of testing is complete; next round begins in May

- School Improvement Plan: will be working on closing out this year
- SAC Budget- \$7,691.00
 - Proposal of SAC fund usage – voting on \$5,000 from SAC budget to be used toward iReady licenses for the 2019-2020 school year. This includes ability to access the diagnostic test.
 - All in Favor – 11/11 present voting members
- SAF Report: Superintendent was in attendance. Safety was discussed specific to elementary, middle, and high school levels. Net loss of students in Broward County is about 2,000. Vaping has been a major concern and expulsions are increasing (10x); Students Working Against Tobacco group has been established. SMART bond renovations have started, many are in the contract process. Per student funding in Florida is approximately \$4,000 less than national average. Expanded voucher programs will continue. Several plans exist right now in the legislature. Parents are encouraged to provide input via www.browardschools.com/leaor. Recommended apps for students and parents include Safer Watch App as part of “See something, say something” program. Conversation is ongoing about metal detectors and random pat downs. Parents are also encouraged to check the backpacks of their students. No more unannounced drills will occur; if a drill is called, the word “drill” will be used.
