- Meeting called to order at 3:15 PM
- SAF Report: Superintendent was in attendance. Safety was discussed specific to elementary, middle, and high school levels. Net loss of students in Broward County is about 2,000. Vaping has been a major concern and expulsions are increasing (10x); Students Working Against Tobacco group has been established. SMART bond renovations have started, many are in the contract process. Per student funding in Florida is approximately \$4,000 less than national average. Expanded voucher programs will continue. Several plans exist right now in the legislature. Parents are encouraged to provide input via [www.browardschools.com/leaor](http://www.browardschools.com/leaor). Recommended apps for students and parents include Safer Watch App as part of “See something, say something” program. Conversation is ongoing about metal detectors and random pat downs. Parents are also encouraged to check the backpacks of their students. No more unannounced drills will occur; if a drill is called, the word “drill” will be used.
