PTO Updates

- PTO has written the check for the new office front door. We anticipate it will be delivered at the end of May. PTO was able to provide funding for technology this year. 5th grade activities are upcoming.
- The next PTO meeting is May 23rd at 6:00 and the board members will be announced. A ballot was put together by the nomination committee. Parents/guardians and faculty of Silver Ridge can vote. The ballot will be available on our school website and can be sent in or brought into the office on Tuesday, May 21st or between 6:00-6:30 on Thursday, May 23rd. Ms. McLaughlin will also be speaking at the May PTO meeting.

- Partnership Report
 - Everything is great!
- IZone Report
 - There are a few principal moves happening within our zone, mostly per principal request. Phil Bullock is moving to Flamingo Elementary.

Principal's Report

- Kindergarten swimming is underway. Ms. Borowski spoke with the Kindergarten teachers who expressed that swimming is a lot of work, but worth it! It is a great way for children to learn how to swim. Ms. Borowski will be working with the Kindergarten team to address parent concerns about children changing after swimming.
- o The A/C project will begin this summer. Ms. Borowski does not yet have the schedule of when the work will take place. She will be meeting with the crew

every 2 weeks. The crew is starting with the front office and cafeteria. The work will not be completed by the time school starts, but there are three portables available for use next school year. Parents and teachers should keep in mind that we will all need to be as flexible as possible to get the job done as quickly as possible.

Safety

- Ms. Borowski opened discussion for safety and security concerns. As mentioned by PTO, a new buzzer system will be installed at the front office door.
- We are working on a system and procedures for when a child becomes ill during a Code Red drill.
- Administration is going to work on helping teachers and students know what to do during a Code Red in the event the regular location for hiding is unavailable or inaccessible.

Data Review

- We are waiting for 3rd-5th FSA scores. In addition, we are completing alternative assessments. Primary EOY testing is also underway.
- The state of Florida has produced report cards for schools. Any school's data in the state can be viewed on the Florida DOE's website. Information available includes school grades, demographic information, and performance data based on specific subgroups (ESE, ELL, etc.). The data is compared to other schools in the county and in the state.

 This year's plan is wrapping up. The team will be working on the plan for 2019-2020 early next year.
