- SMART Bond Report: Project Charter Meeting
 - See presentation for details.
 - Concern raised about renovations being done to exterior doors, then redone to comply with single entry. Team reports that those are two separate funds and projects.
 - O Concern raised that two-story building AC will not be addressed. SMART Bond money was not allocated for this building based on 2014 needs assessment; ACs are replaced in this building as needed through separate funds. It will be reviewed and looked at more carefully due to potential discrepancies in needs.
 - Process includes permit, selecting a vendor, and implementing. Goal is to avoid interruption of academic activities. That phasing/staging plan is reviewed with the principal. Plan begins conceptually and specifies work/contractor locations
 - Single Point of Entry standards: Parameter fencing, single point of entry and sign-in before accessing campus. Silver Ridge meets these standards.
 - Once permit is received (hopefully before January 2019), 4-5 months selecting contractors, taking bids, handling procurement/capital and administrative needs
 - Bulk of work to be done is mechanical
- Equity Committee Updates
 - Inclusive Schools Week is early December. Plans will be discussed at Equity Team meeting on November 15th. Team is also working on a staff training.
- PTO Updates
 - We did very well with the Boosterthon. Looking for feedback from teachers.
 We made over \$28,000 and surpassed funds from last year.
 - PTO meeting is November 30th at 8:15
 - Dress-down day was very successful we made about \$250
