A. GUIDANCE

The school counseling department has been working on preparing everything for this testing season. We are also working on the following:

- Monitoring Course Recovery
- Monitoring grades
- Student Mediations

B. ESE

- SVE classes have just finished FSAA testing-
- We are getting reports ready to send students to Extended School Year-this year it will be at Coconut Creek High School
- We finished Matriculation meetings to high school-this year we are sending 12 SVE students to Monarch, Deerfield Beach and Coconut Creek High
- Students in General education classes are working on Crunch Time studies for the FSA exams in May
- 6th graders are looking forward to the 6th grade trip to Lion Country Safari
- 8th graders are just beginning to talk about the 8th grade end of year trip and dance

C. UNIFIED ARTS

- Mr. La Spina's homeroom/period 1 class continues to put on the live, daily morning show and update the
 daily scrolling announcements for the school.
- His Video Production classes are learning how to make movie trailers using the effects in iMovie program with their previous project footage.
- Every single one of Mr. La Spina's 7th graders are Industry Certified in Microsoft WORD!
- 90% of his 8th grade LEEO class, so far, are now Industry Certified in Excel or Outlook giving them the ENTIRE BUNDLE of Microsoft!
- 70% of his 6th grade LEEO class, so far, is Industry Certified in PowerPoint!
- His LEEO classes continue to run the Business of Textile Recycling and advertising for it using PowerPoint and iMovie.
- Yearbook- finishing up the design of book and creating short movies for layouts
- DIT- Successfully completed 2 digital tools working on the 3rd
- CAB & CP- finishing up digital tool exams and beginning work on learning.com
- In Spanish 1students are working on the following: Direct object pronouns, preposition a, kitchen
 utensils, kitchen etiquette, irregular verbs in the first-person singular (yo) conjugations, and indirect
 object pronouns.
- In Band, Students are memorizing scales and preparing new music for the Spring concerts.
- Jazz Band rehearsing every Tuesday after school. Some students are preparing for solo and ensemble assessments at Ramblewood on 4/27.
- In **Spanish 2**, My students are learning how to use informal and formal commands, vocabulary related to packaging and containers and vocabulary related to the kitchen.

6th Grade

 All the students are working on Properties of Stars and Structure of the Universe. The Museum of Discovery brought their mobile planetarium for 4 days. Most of the 6th graders were able to participate in the show Journey to the Stars which supported the curriculum being taught in the class.

8th Grade

- All the classes are into their review for the state test while finishing their unit on Force and Motion.
- The GEARS and Honor Biology students went to the Frost Museum in Miami on March 5th. The museum is 6 floors of hands on activities as well as a wonderful Planetarium show.

6th Grade

Teachers are finishing the units on Greece and will be starting Ancient Rome after Spring Break.

7th Grade

 Finishing up State / Local Government, comparing national constitution to Florida constitution, and after Spring Break will conclude new content with Foreign Policy. That will leave about 4 weeks for review.

8th Grade

Reviewing Westward Expansion, Manifest Destiny, and the Monroe Doctrine

G. MATH

6th, 7th and 8th grade -

All are working on their Crunch Time Plan, remediating and enriching the weakest standards. According
to the holistic post-test, which was an apples to apples comparison to the pre-test, in 6th grade, statistics
& probability was the weakest standard; however, the teachers hadn't gotten through this unit of study
at the time of the assessment. In 7th grade, expressions and equations was the weakest followed by
geometry. Because expressions and equations is vital in 8th grade, teachers will dig deep in this domain.
in 8th grade, geometry and the number system were the weakest. All grade levels are now spiraling and
spending extra time reteaching those domains that require extra instruction and practice.

Algebra

• They're completing the unit on quadratics. Quadratics is a big part of the EOC. They will be moving forward with exponential functions followed by statistics and probability. Algebra has a multitude of standards that dig deep. Getting through them all with a reasonable degree of conceptual understanding requires time. Algebra students are the largest in attendance at H.E.L.P. Academy, but it's important that we get even more in attendance. To reiterate from the last meeting, it is imperative at this time that students utilize the resources (videos and Test Yourself - Practice Tools) available to them in Math/Algebra Nation. This is the best know resource at this time for independent preparation.

Geometry

 Our Geometry students continue to prepare for their high school EOC exam. There continue to be resources available on Math (Algebra) Nation to aid in EOC prep.

H. READING

- The Reading Department is currently facilitating its "Crunch Time" action plan. Reteach, Remediation, and Assessment will be conducted to lessen the gap and increase proficiency.
- FAIR Testing will be administered in the month of April.
- I Ready is being implemented on a 45 minute minimum exposure per week, and we are very excited with the growth we are seeing.
