SAC Minutes - March 7, 2019

1. Call to Order:

Dr. Howard motioned to approve the minutes from February 19, 2019, with any necessary corrections. Motion passed and approved.

New Business:

3. Principal's Message:

- Principle Wynter's welcomed all parents and shared that the Spring Curriculum Parent Night breakout sessions would involve FSA strategies and practice materials that their child could use at home.
- Ms. Wynter informed all parents of the Smart Bond Ballot and what it would be used for within the school.

Department Updates:

A. GUIDANCE

- All grades are working on course recovery using USA test prep, IXL or classroom assignments to make-up any missing points required for promotion.
- SEL classroom visits continue
- Matriculation/course selection for School Year 19-20 completed.
- School Counselors and the testing team are preparing for the upcoming FSA/EOC test season.

B. ESE

- The students in the SVE classes are currently being tested individually on the FSAA-The Florida Alternate Assessment for students being instructed on Access Points.
- The ESE Support teachers are working with our students in General education classes in making sure that they have everything they need to pass their courses for the third marking period
- Ms. Gains, our 8th grade ESE Support teacher will be accompanying one of our ESE students on the 8th grade trip to Washington DC.

C. UNIFIED ARTS

- **Spanish 2** students are working with food vocabulary in the context of North America and expressions to use in a restaurant when ordering and asking for things.

- In Mr. La Spina's **Morning Crew** continues to execute the daily live morning show jobs and create and post the scrolling announcements.
- His **Video Production** classes are filming and editing in iMovie their "How-To" projects which are like DIY videos.
- Mr. La Spina's **LEEO** class is now Industry Certified in Microsoft Word! They are now creating Self Control and Tolerance Video Vignettes for our Social Emotional Learning.
- Mr. La Spina's 6th and 8th grade classes are preparing to get certified in Microsoft Office PowerPoint and Excel. From these two classes, only 18 more students need to test to be CERTIFIED!
- In STEM, Students are participating in the rocket lab, they are learning mean median and mode as well time distance and speed formulas for this week.
- **6th Grade Robotics** - Are currently learning how to use the Ultrasonic sensor to detect objects in front of their robots. Their final challenge in this module is to program their robots to navigate through a maze using the ultrasonic sensor to detect the location of walls.
- **7th Grade Engineering** - Students are completing construction of their mousetrap powered cars and preparing a technical report documenting the construction process. We hope to be racing the mousetrap cars in the Gym or MPR in the coming days.
- **8th Grade Advanced Information Technology** - Students are completing the unit of binary representation of data, including binary representation of numbers and letters using the ASCII character set.

D. SCIENCE
6th Grade

- All the students are working on Properties of Stars and Structure of the Universe. The Museum of Discovery brought their mobile planetarium for 4 days. Most of the 6th graders were able to participate in the show Journey to the Stars which supported the curriculum being taught in the class.

8th Grade

- All the classes are into their review for the state test while finishing their unit on Force and Motion.
- The GEARS and Honor Biology students went to the Frost Museum in Miami on March 5th. The museum is 6 floors of hands on activities as well as a wonderful Planetarium show.

F. SOCIAL STUDIES

6th Grade

- Teachers are finishing the units on Greece and will be starting Ancient Rome after Spring Break.

7th Grade

- Finishing up State / Local Government, comparing national constitution to Florida constitution, and after Spring Break will conclude new content with Foreign Policy. That will leave about 4 weeks for review.

8th Grade

- Reviewing Westward Expansion, Manifest Destiny, and the Monroe Doctrine

G. MATH

6th Grade

- Finishing up Geometry and Statistics; after Spring Break, they'll be working on their Crunch Time Plan, remediating and enriching the weakest standards. The FSA content focus is broken down into Ratio and Proportional Relationships (15%), Expressions and Equations (30%), Geometry (15%), Statistics & Probability (19%), and The Number System (21%).

7th Grade

- Finishing up Geometry and they've started reviewing; after Spring Break, they'll be working on their Crunch Time Plan, remediating and enriching the weakest standards. The FSA content focus is broken down into Ratio and Proportional Relationships (15%), Expressions and Equations (30%), Geometry (15%), Statistics & Probability (19%), and The Number System (21%).

8th Grade

- Finishing up angle relationships and going to Pythagorean Theorem within their Geometry unit next. They too will go into their Crunch Time Plan after Spring Break. The FSA content focus for 8th grade consists of Expressions and Equations (30%), Geometry (27%), Functions (25%), and Statistics and Probability and The Number System (18%).

Algebra

- They've been working on Polynomials and Quadratics since January. It's a very heavily weighted unit. The EOC content focus for Algebra consists of Algebra and Modeling (41%), Functions and Modeling (40%), and Statistics and The Number System (19%). **It is imperative at this time that students really utilize the resources (videos and Test Yourself - Practice Tools) available to them in Math/Algebra Nation. This is the best know resource at this time for independent preparation.**

Geometry

- Our Geometry students have been working on solid figures...volume, surface area, etc. The content focus in Geometry is broken down into Congruence, Similarity, Right Triangles and Trigonometry (46%), Circles, Geometric Measurement, and Geometric Properties with Equations (38%), and Modeling with Geometry (16%). There are also resources available on Math (Algebra) Nation to aid in EOC prep.

H. READING

- Reading is working on Crunch time plans for FSA testing, and getting ready to administer FAIR 3. Holistic Reading test will be the week on March 11th. Make up days for holistic test will be Friday March 15th. Results from the holistic test will (lowest standards).
- Crunch Time starts April 3, 2019.

I. ELL

- The ACCESS ELL State Assessment is about 70% complete. All testing must be completed by the end of March.
- ESOL Camp begins March 4, 2019. It will run for approximately two months.
