All school board employees currently on staff at Quiet Waters Elementary School, including administration, instructional, paraprofessionals, facilities service staff, clerical, and food service staff are eligible to vote.

Due to the lack of specific funding information, it was recommended that percentages be utilized when creating award distribution proposals.

The School Advisory Council meeting was called to order at 7:08 a.m. in the Media Center by Nina Cohen. A quorum was present and minutes were approved as read. A motion to approve minutes was made by Kristen Blankenship and seconded by Ms. McCullough.

SCHOOL RECOGNITION FUNDS:

Neither proposal submitted received a majority vote. Proposal #1- 48 votes, proposal #2- 31 votes, and Proposal #3- 27 votes.

Three new proposals were submitted. Proposal #1 did not speak about 99 days, the way the proposal was submitted. Proposal #2 changed the percentages into shares (1 share was based on \$100). Proposal #3 suggested 50% go back to teachers and 50% go back to full time staff members.

A motion was made by Mr. Santanta to go with the old proposal #1 and the new proposal #3 and a none of the above. It was seconded by Mr. Bachrach.

The proposals will be reviewed through Friday and voting will take place on Monday the 25th. We need a 51% majority vote to pass.

A proposal must be approved by 2/1 or it will default to classrooms teachers only (those who have students assigned to their class).

Meeting was adjourned at 7:29 a.m. Next meeting will be February 29, 2016.
